## TENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME LITURGY OF THE WORD

### READING I —GN 3:9-15

After the man, Adam, had eaten of the tree, the LORD God called to the man and asked him, "Where are you?" He answered, "I heard you in the garden; but I was afraid, because I was naked, so I hid myself." Then he asked, "Who told you that you were naked? You have eaten, then, from the tree of which I had forbidden you to eat!" The man replied, "The woman whom you put here with me—she gave me fruit from the tree, and so I ate it." The LORD God then asked the woman, "Why did you do such a thing?" The woman answered, "The serpent tricked me into it, so I ate it."

Then the LORD God said to the serpent: "Because you have done this, you shall be banned from all the animals and from all the wild creatures; on your belly shall you crawl, and dirt shall you eat all the days of your life. I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; he will strike at your head, while you strike at his heel."

### READING II —2 COR 4:13—5:1

Brothers and sisters:

Since we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, *I believed, therefore I spoke*, we too believe and therefore we speak, knowing that the one who raised the Lord Jesus will raise us also with Jesus and place us with you in his presence. Everything indeed is for you, so that the grace bestowed in abundance on more and more people may cause the thanksgiving to overflow for the glory of God. Therefore, we are not discouraged; rather, although our outer self is wasting away, our inner self is being renewed day by day. For this momentary light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison, as we look not to what is seen but to what is unseen; for what is seen is transitory, but what is unseen is eternal. For we know that if our earthly dwelling, a tent, should be destroyed, we have a building from God, a dwelling not made with hands, eternal in heaven.

### GOSPEL —MK 3:20-35

Jesus came home with his disciples. Again the crowd gathered, making it impossible for them even to eat. When his relatives heard of this they set out to seize him, for they said, "He is out of his mind." The scribes who had come from Jerusalem said, "He is possessed by Beelzebul," and "By the prince of demons he drives out demons."

Summoning them, he began to speak to them in parables, "How can Satan drive out Satan? If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. And if a house is divided against itself, that house will not be able to stand. And if Satan has risen up against himself and is divided, he cannot stand; that is the end of him. But no one can enter a strong man's house to plunder his property unless he first ties up the strong man. Then he can plunder the house. Amen, I say to you, all sins and all blasphemies that people utter will be forgiven them. But whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit will never have forgiveness, but is guilty of an everlasting sin." For they had said, "He has an unclean spirit."

His mother and his brothers arrived. Standing outside they sent word to him and called him. A crowd seated around him told him, "Your mother and your brothers and your sisters are outside asking for you." But he said to them in reply, "Who are my mother and my brothers?" And looking around at those seated in the circle he said, "Here are my mother and my brothers. For whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother."

## **WE MUST BUILD OUR LIVES UPON JESUS.**

Anyone who has ever built a home or any other sort of building knows just how important the foundation is. Before a wall is built or a roof covers the structure, the foundation must be set firmly in place. A firm foundation requires an immense amount of work and preparation. If the foundation is built on shifting or unstable ground, the building will ultimately fail – it is just a matter of time.

In a very real sense, Jesus is challenging us as disciples to pay attention to the foundation that supports our daily life. In today's Gospel, Jesus rightly notes that a spiritual house built upon a shaky foundation is bound to fail. Some of the folks who insult Jesus in the Gospel think he is mad – that he is in league with the devil himself. As Jesus notes, a house built on such a foundation will collapse against itself.

To some, however, building a house upon the foundation of Jesus may seem like utter insanity. Why would we wish to do such a thing? After all, a strong and secure life requires that we have the best of

everything. Some say that an even better and more successful life is one in which we have achieved every measure of success that is possible, so that people admire or envy us, so that we have power and influence that we can wield in order to determine our own destiny. This is the most solid foundation upon which to build one's life – from the *world's* perspective.

Jesus reminds us that if our lives are built only upon power, influence, prestige or achievement, they will ultimately come tumbling down. At the conclusion of today's Gospel, Jesus gives us a clue about what leads to true satisfaction. As he speaks to his disciples, he reminds us that the ultimate strength in our lives comes from a living and loving relationship with him and with the people of his Church.

If Jesus and the life to which he calls us become the central focus of our everyday living, then we live as members of his family – we are his brother and sisters. Like younger siblings, we have the opportunity to look up to Jesus, to emulate his ways of selfless life and love, to cooperate with his grace in order to bring peace and mercy more firmly into our world. What a joy that Jesus teaches us by word and example to live our lives with his life and love as both foundation and cornerstone.

## WHAT DO YOU HEAR? A Spiritual Reflection

What do you hear when you go to church on Sunday? People talking? Babies crying? The organist and choir warming up? Then what? The welcome greeting and page number of the opening song? The Sign of the Cross, the Penitential Rite, the Gloria, the Scripture readings, the homily?

There's lots of listening to lots of words. But what do you really hear? What really registers?

At each weekend Mass for the last six months or so, I've asked the congregation to listen and select one phrase or one sentence from the Scripture readings that touches their hearts, a phrase they believe God is trying to say directly to them at Mass.

Next weekend at Mass, try it yourself. Select one thing you sense God is saying to you in the readings. At the end of Mass, use a journal (like the [Mass Journal](#)) to write down that one thing. Savor whatever it is God has said to you—he intended it for you.

How else do you hear God's voice? For too many years I took that word "hear" much too literally. I always wondered why I did not hear an audible God-like voice. Maybe I expected to be knocked down like Saul on his way to Damascus with a voice saying, "Bob, why are you ignoring me?"

While you read this, I will be on Dynamic Catholic's Camino de Santiago pilgrimage in northern Spain. I learned on last year's Camino pilgrimage to "hear" God with my five senses. One day I decided to "hear" God with my eyes in the many colors and hues of trees, bushes, birds, flowers, and animals. Another day I hiked while I listened for God's message to me in my sense of smell. God spoke to me in the odors of the farms and restaurants, the animals and ointments. A third day, God spoke to me in my sense of touch: in the wind on my face and back, the rain, the sun, the textures of buildings, my walking stick, and my aching feet. A fourth day I utilized my ears, and the last day my sense of taste.

How do you hear God speak to you? God does speak to us regularly:

"God said to Moses . . ."

"God spoke to Adam, saying . . ."

"God spoke to me through the morning sunrise . . . in the evening shadows, in the depth of my heart . . . in the silence of my classroom . . . in the writings of St. Augustine, or Henri Nouwen, or Pope Francis."

And, as Eli said to Samuel in 1 Samuel, "The next time you hear that voice, say, 'Speak, Lord, your servant is listening.'"

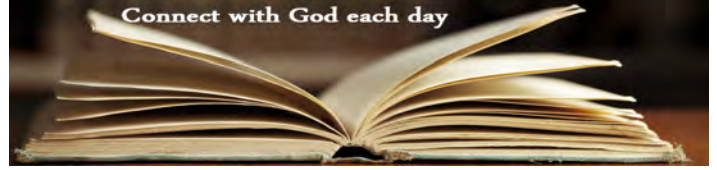

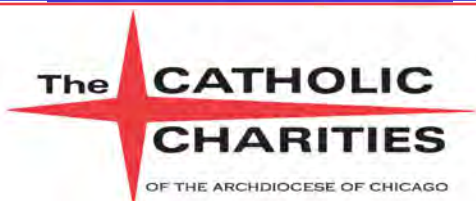
