LITURGY OF THE WORD**

READING I — **AM 7:12-15**

Amaziah, priest of Bethel, said to Amos, "Off with you, visionary, flee to the land of Judah! There earn your bread by prophesying, but never again prophesy in Bethel; for it is the king's sanctuary and a royal temple." Amos answered Amaziah, "I was no prophet, nor have I belonged to a company of prophets; I was a shepherd and a dresser of sycamores. The LORD took me from following the flock, and said to me, Go, prophesy to my people Israel."

READING II — **EPH 1:3-10**

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavens, as he chose us in him, before the foundation of the world, to be holy and without blemish before him. In love he destined us for adoption to himself through Jesus Christ, in accord with the favor of his will, for the praise of the glory of God's grace that he granted us in the beloved.

In him we have redemption by his blood, the forgiveness of transgressions, in accord with the riches of his grace that he lavished upon us. In all wisdom and insight, he has made known to us the mystery of his will in accord with his favor that he set forth in him as a plan for the fullness of times, to sum up all things in Christ, in heaven and on earth.

GOSPEL — **MK 6:7-13**

Jesus summoned the Twelve and began to send them out two by two and gave them authority over unclean spirits. He instructed them to take nothing for the journey but a walking stick—no food, no sack, no money in their belts. They were, however, to wear sandals but not a second tunic. He said to them, "Wherever you enter a house, stay there until you leave. Whatever place does not welcome you or listen to you, leave there and shake the dust off your feet in testimony against them." So they went off and preached repentance. The Twelve drove out many demons, and they anointed with oil many who were sick and cured them.

Stick together. Love each other, and together: Look to Jesus in Prayer.

GOD HAS CHOSEN US TO BE HIS DISCIPLES, AND NOW SENDS US OUT TO BRING HIS LOVE AND MERCY TO THE WORLD.

Who remembers being out at recess during school, and picking teams? It could be scary, thinking about how that would turn out. Would we be picked? Would someone choose us? Were we good enough? Many of us may approach our faith and relationship with Jesus this way, asking whether or not God will choose us, whether or not we're good enough. The good news for each of us today is that God has already chosen us, and sends us out on a mission that we can accomplish through his grace, power and authority.

First, we are not alone. Looking around us today, there are people here who are our brothers and sisters in Christ – we are not alone in this mission! Jesus sent his disciples out two by two, and we, too, are encouraged to find others who can walk with us as we strive to follow Jesus.

Second, it's not all up to us. Jesus didn't send the disciples out saying, "Do your best!" Jesus sent them out and gave them authority. As we strive to act as disciples of Jesus and to carry out the mission which he has entrusted to us, we must recognize that he's not standing at a distance watching us, grading us or critiquing us. Jesus is here in the midst of our struggles giving us strength – in the midst of our victories rejoicing with us. He does not ask us to go out with only our natural abilities, but gives us his strength, power, authority and grace. All that is necessary is for us to receive it.

Finally, Jesus will continue to choose us and work through us, even if we fail over and over again. There is a striking aspect in this Gospel passage. The Scripture simply says, The Twelve drove out many demons, and they anointed with oil many who were sick and cured them. This means that Judas, who eventually betrayed Jesus, would have been included in that number. Judas – through the power and authority of Jesus – healed the sick, preached repentance and drove out demons.

In our lives, there will be times when we choose against Jesus, when we betray him, when we deny him – but Jesus never gives up on us. In those moments, we are called to repentance, and then to begin to walk with Jesus again. If Judas was able to do such mighty works before his eventual turning away from God, what might Jesus do in and through us if we allow him to?

THE HEART OF THE MATTER: TIME FOR REFLECTION AND SPIRITUAL GROWTH

As we continue on with this week, we might take some time to reflect on this Gospel passage, not as something that happened millennia ago, but as an encounter with Jesus today. And as we encounter Jesus in Word and sacrament, let us allow him to transform us, and to reveal how he is choosing us and sending us out. **Who is it he wants to give us as a partner in this mission? And how is he calling us to repent of the failures of our past and to persevere in following after him despite our weaknesses? What might Jesus do in and through us if we allow him to?**

3 Steps for Couples to Get on the Same Financial Page

What's going on here? According to a 2014 study by Money Magazine, four out of five couples say they're on the same page as their partner about money. But according to the same survey, 70 percent of married couples argue about money. Evidently, some couples aren't clear on what it means to be on the same page financially. Getting on the same page financially means having a common goal to work towards. They are simple—but of course simple doesn't always mean easy. It's also not a fix-it-quick process. It will take a little time.

STEP 1: START DREAMING AGAIN.

One reason most people don't plan financially is that they don't have anything to plan for. Follow these simple steps to answer the question: **What are we saving for?**

1. Sit down with your spouse and write a list of one hundred dreams across all areas of your life.
2. Dream without limits.
3. When the list is done, look through it and pick out the one that is most important to you for the next year, the next five years, and the next ten years.

Once you have identified and agreed on a few dreams, begin to plan financially for the dream. Estimate how much it will cost, and set a target date when you want to achieve it. Divide the cost by the number of months until your target date, and you will know how much you have to save each month to achieve that dream. **If your dreams are compelling enough, you will make whatever adjustments that are necessary to reach them.**

STEP 2: HAVE ONE FINANCIAL MEETING PER MONTH.

Find an hour together (maybe over coffee) with the following as the only agenda:

1. Create a budget. Nothing complicated, especially if you are new to this. Simply write down your known expenses and known income.
 2. What went right last month?
 3. What went wrong last month?
- Chances are you will disagree about an expense or two the first time. That's okay. Use it as a chance to see where the gaps are in your financial perceptions, and then, as you start to track the expenses you listed in your budget, you can close those gaps with facts. **Financial harmony in a relationship is a total game-changer.** Couples who keep a monthly budget report having an enormously higher rate of marital satisfaction compared to couples that don't.

STEP 3: TAKE IT EASY ON EACH OTHER.

Each person in a marriage brings with them several factors that influence the way they approach finances: family history, personality type, education, etc. There are a couple of easy ways to make sure you are taking it easy on your spouse. **First**, remember that budgeting is not a tool to rein in your spouse. It is not a way to control your spouse. **Second**, budgeting doesn't mean you have to give up everything you enjoy. It may be important to create budget categories for each spouse that allows them to spend some amount on things they enjoy each month that fits within the budget but is not subject to a great deal of scrutiny. Maybe it's a morning cup of coffee, or taking advantage of a great deal. **Third**, avoid criticizing your spouse, or acting like all of the financial difficulties rest on one person's shoulders. Avoid lying to each other financially, and work together for the betterment of your marriage. Couples regularly comment about how freeing it is to be in charge of their own money instead of the other way around.

Financial harmony in a relationship is a total game-changer. Most financial issues are not related to how much money, but rather how much effort a couple is willing to put forth to preserve and build their most important relationship. Get your marriage on the same page financially and you will write a book that is better than you ever dreamed.

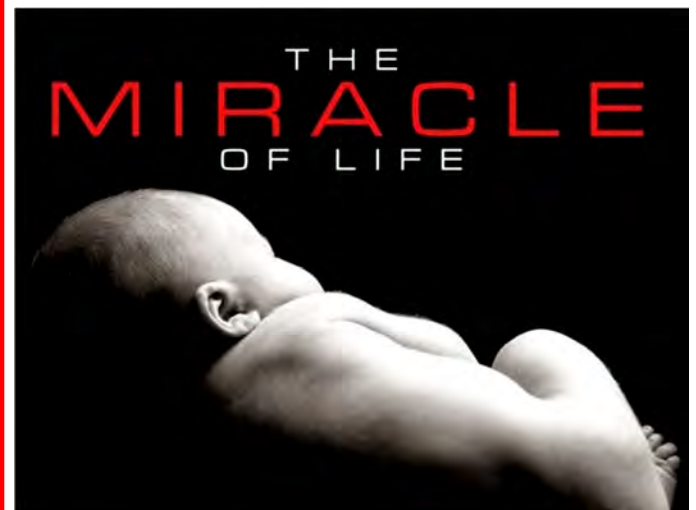
We ask that you spiritually adopt an unborn child. This is done by praying for one particular, but unknown child; that he or she is allowed the gift of life.

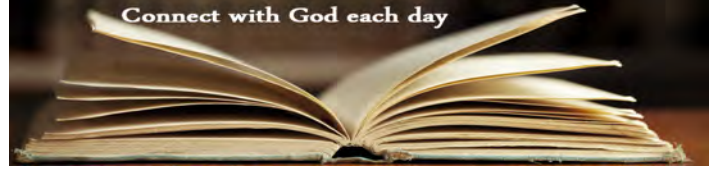
