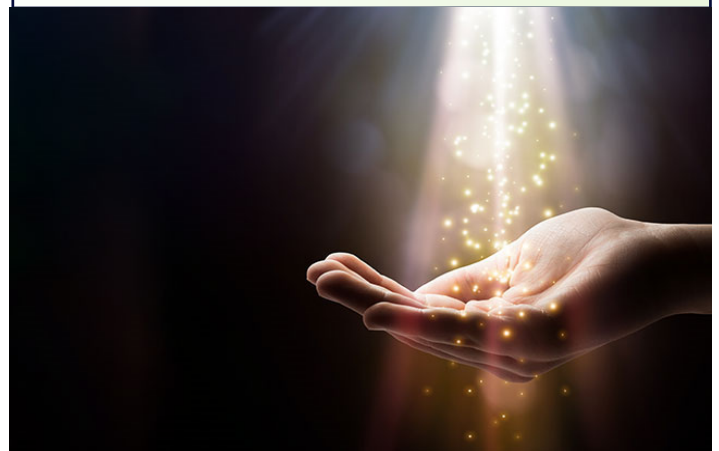

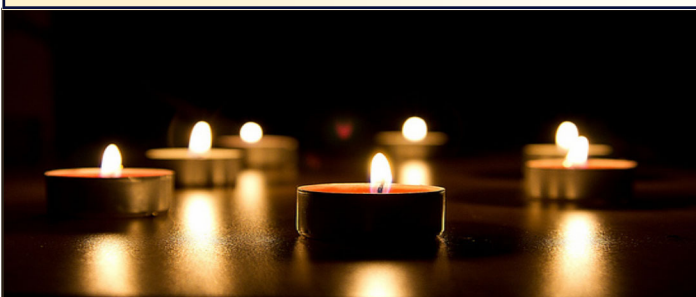

## EASTER SUNDAY LITURGY OF THE WORD

### READING I — ACTS 10:34A, 37-43

Peter proceeded to speak and said: "You know what has happened all over Judea, beginning in Galilee after the baptism that John preached, how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power. He went about doing good and healing all those oppressed by the devil, for God was with him. We are witnesses of all that he did both in the country of the Jews and in Jerusalem. They put him to death by hanging him on a tree. This man God raised on the third day and granted that he be visible, not to all the people, but to us, the witnesses chosen by God in advance, who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead. He commissioned us to preach to the people and testify that he is the one appointed by God as judge of the living and the dead. To him all the prophets bear witness, that everyone who believes in him will receive forgiveness of sins through his name."

So Peter and the other disciple went out and came to the tomb. They both ran, but the other disciple ran faster than Peter and arrived at the tomb first; he bent down and saw the burial cloths there, but did not go in. When Simon Peter arrived after him, he went into the tomb and saw the burial cloths there, and the cloth that had covered his head, not with the burial cloths but rolled up in a separate place. Then the other disciple also went in, the one who had arrived at the tomb first, and he saw and believed. For they did not yet understand the Scripture that he had to rise from the dead.

## Why Seek the Living Among the Dead

Resurrection Greetings!

In their fright the women bowed down with their faces to the ground, but the men said to them, "Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here; he has risen! Remember how he told you, while he was still with you in Galilee:

The two angels that were sitting by the empty tomb of Christ asked the women who had come to bring spices to the tomb as a custom and sign of respect, "why do you seek the living among the dead"?

In this world, we often encounter people who might be somewhat similar in that they only view the Bible as a historical document and go to church as if they were going to a memorial service. We must know that Jesus is alive and is not among the dead! He lives and reigns in our midst, in the hearts of believers, so there's no reason to be sad and somber. He lives!

Do you look for Jesus among the living? Do you expect him to be active in the world and the church? Look for signs of his power—they are all around you.

As we enter the season we celebrate the Resurrection and as we gather together in this Holy Place may we never lose sight of the fact that Jesus is alive. It is through Him that we have freedom IF we receive that work He did for us!

We've received life so let's be givers of life! Use your words to bless and encourage one another, especially during this time that people are a bit more open to hearing the Good News of the Gospel!

These women who had gone to the tomb to find a "dead Jesus" realized quite quickly that He wasn't there. One can only imagine the initial thoughts that raced through their minds as they expected one thing, but found quite another.

Too often people have an idea of who Jesus is. They have pre-conceived notions that may have formed over the years as "dead and dry" religion convinced them that Jesus is much the same way. There is something powerful and life-giving about an encounter with Jesus on a personal level as these women would soon find out!

This world needs hope. Our nation needs hope. Families need hope. This hope begins within the hearts and minds of individuals just like you and me.

May you and yours have a wonderful season of celebrating the Resurrection of Christ!

# 8 Letter from the Archbishop

Easter 2019

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

As we walk on our life journeys in this world, we may often feel overwhelmed. Struggle and suffering can mark our lives because of health issues, job insecurity, family concerns, or the painful loss of a loved one. The world itself, in Saint Paul's words, "has been groaning" (Roman 8:22), as it struggles with wars, violence, ecological degradation, economic injustice, and natural disasters. And as we are keenly aware this past year, the Church herself has struggled mightily with the shameful legacy of abuse and its mismanagement.

It seems that the landscape of our lives is entirely shaped by struggle and suffering. And that might seem to be the sum and substance of it all, but, in faith, we know that it is not. Our celebration of the Lord's Resurrection in this Easter season opens our eyes beyond this desperate landscape to a new and hope-filled horizon. There is more to the story than our struggle and suffering. In the Resurrection of Jesus, we can begin to see a new life ahead of us that God offers to us.

As we go forth in this Easter season, I am reminded of the great Psalm 118 that the Church so often prays:

*I was thrust down, thrust down and falling, but the  
Lord was my helper.  
The Lord is my strength and my song; and has  
been my savior.  
There are shouts of joy and victory in the tents  
of the just. (vv. 13-15)*

May this Easter season renew within you and your loved ones the conviction that God is your helper and an abiding awareness of your victory in the Risen Lord Jesus.

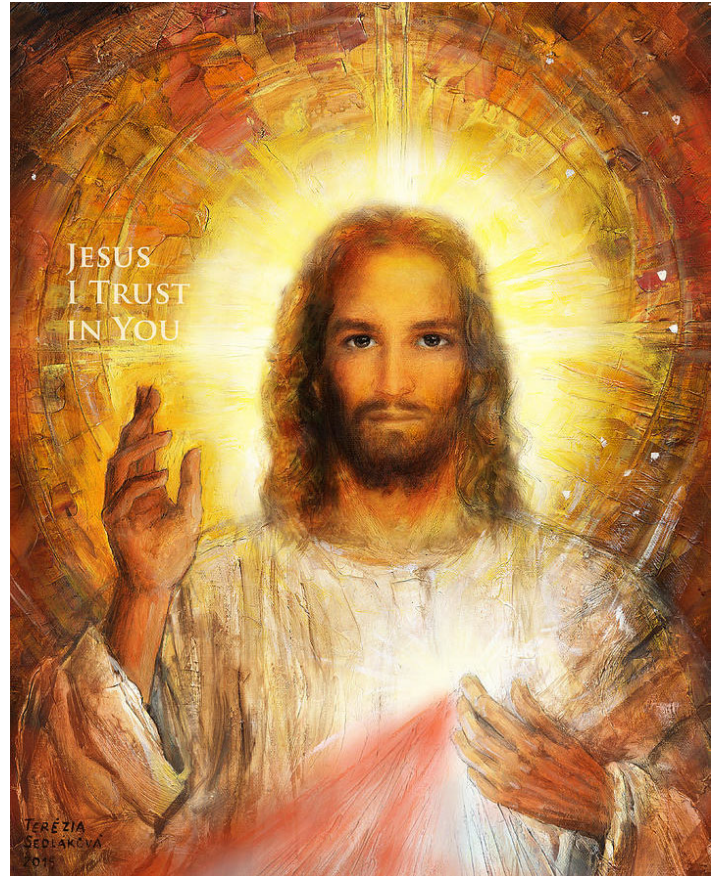

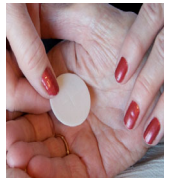

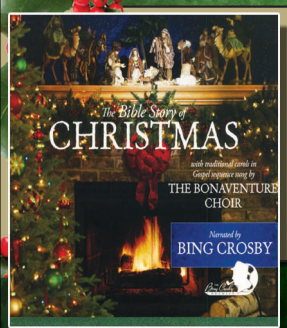
