WHAT IF WE DO IT RIGHT...?

We have known for some time that it was coming. For years we have been hearing about, praying about, thinking about and talking about **Renew My Church**. A year ago we were informed that our **RMC grouping** had been altered and finalized: **Saint Mary of the Annunciation** (Mundelein), **Santa Maria del Popolo** (Mundelein), **Saint Frances de Sales** (Lake Zurich), **Transfiguration** (Wauconda) and **Frassati Catholic Academy** (Wauconda). However, we were still in the dark as to when something would happen with this grouping.

Well, the darkness gives way to the light. Our **Renew My Church** grouping is about to be **activated** (That's the word the Archdiocese uses for "something is happening"). While the letter from Cardinal Cupich proclaiming this is still a few weeks or a few months away, we pastors - **Father Jerome Jacob of Saint Mary of the Annunciation, Father Miguel Martinez of Santa Maria del Popolo, Father David Ryan of St. Francis de Sales, Father Juan Pablo of Transfiguration and Ms. Tammy Kleckner, Frassati Catholic Academy Principal** - have been informed that we are scheduled for activation in the spring 2020. We want to take this opportunity to share the news with you.

What exactly does this mean? Basically, before the year 2020 is out the four parishes, specifically, **RMC teams** from each parish, will begin to work on forming a configuration of what our communities will be in the future. The process will begin in its preliminary stage the spring and summer of 2020. During that time the pastors will go off on a short retreat to pray and share ideas about what is to come. Also, the **RMC parish teams** will be formed; the Archdiocese will provide some guidance on how to accomplish this. Then, a series of meetings will commence that will provide the forum for the shaping of our future vision and the means by which this vision can be brought to fulfillment. **The process is scheduled for completion by July 1, 2021.**

The first question many parishioners ask when being informed of this activation process is: "**Does this mean my parish is about to close?**" True, some parishes in the Archdiocese have closed or will need to close because of financial, structural, or personnel constraints. However, this practice of closures is **not** the goal of **Renew My Church**, and to see it as the inevitable conclusion of the process is unwarranted. At this moment, what the final configuration of our parishes will look like is known only in the mind of the Lord. It will be the work of the **RMC process** to discern what is in God's mind and how it can become reality for the good of the Church of Chicago.

The process is sure to bring about some changes. Instead of approaching this process with apprehension, let's put our trust in the Spirit of Jesus who has guided the Church through schisms, scandals, social upheavals, financial downturns, and all sorts of difficulties, and who has never abandoned us. We have no reason to imagine that the Church formed at the cost of the shedding of Christ's blood will suddenly be left to its own devices, bereft of Divine intervention. **Rather than panic, we need to pray earnestly throughout this process to the Lord who companions us through every challenge and trial, trusting that His plan, not ours, will be accomplished.**

We priests are committed to work together with all of you, and to share with you what we hear from the Archdiocese throughout the **RMC process**. May we pray with and for all four of our parishes as we embrace this new experience of Church.

In the meantime, I want to invite all of you to come together and to use this coming months to remember the past with gratitude, to live the present with enthusiasm and to look forward to the future with confidence: **Renew My Church** calls each of us to face our challenges, and commit to a renewal of faith, active participation, engagement in a broader and more diverse family of families and, most importantly, to deepen our personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

To present the best of Transfiguration to the Archdiocese, **difficult decisions will have to be made**. But those considerations will be balanced by the more important questions: *How will this enable us to carry out Christ's mission in the communities we serve here in Transfiguration Parish? Why we think we could remain as Parish? How will this lead to Renewal?*

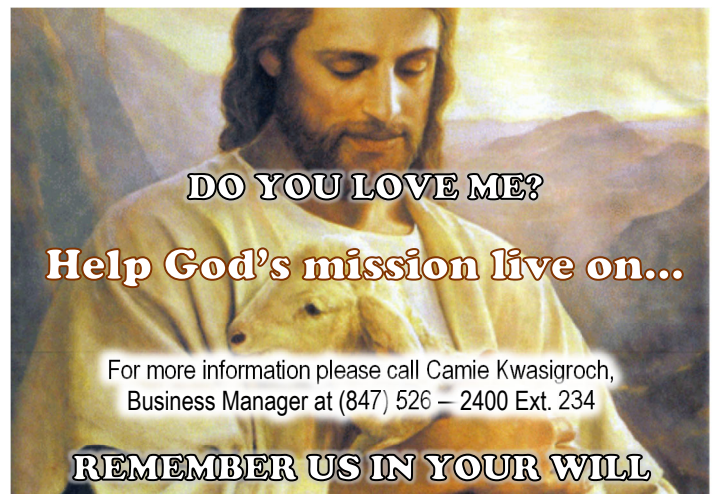

If every other area of this Parish remained at the current level of performance, what is the one area where change would have the greatest impact?

Probably, I would guess:

An increase in Weekly Mass Attendance

Well, we can talk about mass attendance going down in ours and most other parishes or **WE CAN DO something about it.**

We are battling for our parishioners time. More and more people are not seeing the value in church attendance and choose TV, sleep or the internet over church.

If the parish does what its always done, it will continue to get what its always gotten.

I invite you to start afresh from Christ, a special commitment is needed with regard to certain aspects of the Gospel's radical message, but we must be part of Jesus' mission to go and make disciples knowing that the Lord is always with us.

LET US GO FORWARD IN HOPE!

Growing a healthy parish rests on three simple, but not easy strategies that any parish can employ. In these coming months we will look at the core strategies that have driven the transformation of our parish since the beginning of my ministry as pastor of Transfiguration and which offer some action to do church today.

Transfiguration Core Strategies:

1. Reaching the Lost
2. The Weekend Experience
3. Creating a Discipleship Path

I want us all to put our efforts first on Sunday Mass Experience. **WHY?** In other words, why do we need to have a Great Weekend Experience? Mass is mass, right? We have mass, is how we grew up, you go to mass and it wasn't always a great experience.

I believe we need to reflect in the Weekend Experience for three principal reasons:

1. It is the Church Culture
2. It is the platform for all our other efforts
3. It is the opportunity to responds Jesus' call to not only to "proclaim the Good News and make disciples" but to change and transform the world.

Let's be honest.

People will not come to mass or will not comeback to church unless they do not have a great weekend experience.

For most people the weekend experience is Church and therefore is the church's culture. That means that for 80% or so of the people in the church, whatever they experience on the weekend, that is church. They are making decisions in their lives in whatever they experience during that one hour on Sunday. That is the church culture and for that reason if we want people to have a deeper relationship with God and to make Church matter, we need to change our church culture. And we cannot change the church culture unless we change the weekend experience.

For most people, if their experience on Sunday mass is boring and bad they will probably will not come back. My concern for those not coming back is that if someone had a boring experience they might assume that the church is boring and bad and then most probably, will assume that God is boring and irrelevant to their lives.

But what gives me hope is that **YOU ARE HERE, THAT YOU ARE BACK.** That tells me that we might be doing somethings right.

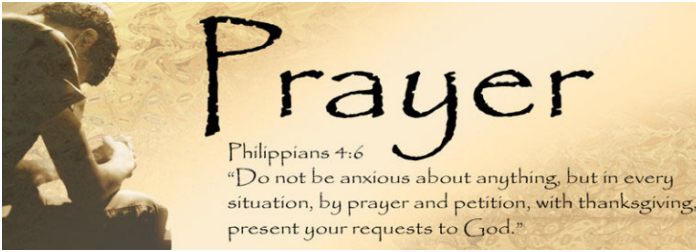
The Eucharist is the source and the summit of our faith, and therefore we need to show to all of you the value of the Eucharist by putting all our time, energy and recourses into the mass.

The weekend experience is one if not the most important ways God will transform us and lead us to happiness. Then, the Liturgy on Sunday should be the maximum impact where we will be reaching all sectors of society. Just think about the Church as the only proposed institution that brings all sectors in society together on a regular basis. On the weekend we bring together: education people, medical people, entertainer people, government leaders, business people, the youth and the old, men and women, etc. **What are we doing with this opportunity?**

The first step to change our weekend Experience:

What we are trying to say, is that to change for the good our weekend experience we need to make some drastic changes: Mass Schedule. With all I mentioned above, I invite you to see the advantages of changing the number of masses on the weekend.

This weekend we are taking this first step that will lead us to change our church culture.

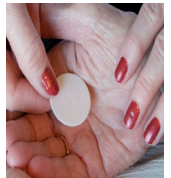

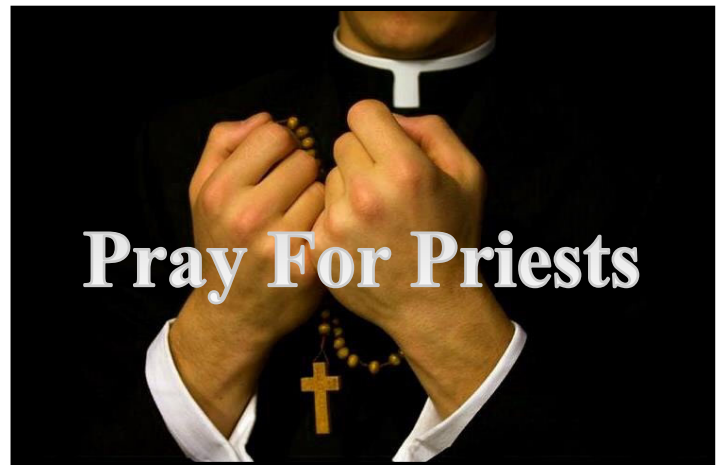
