The New Mass Schedule will help us to improve the quality of the weekend Liturgies. In three areas we consider essential if we want to allow God to transform us through the Eucharist: 1. Music, 2. Message and 3. Ministry.

So, I invite all of you to come together and to use the coming months to remember the past with gratitude, to live the present with enthusiasm and to look forward to the future with confidence.

IN THE EUCHARIST, WE TASTE THE VERY PRESENCE AND MERCY OF CHRIST.

Popularly known as the *Feeding of the Five Thousand*, this miraculous event is found in all four Gospels. For Luke it took place in a *deserted* place, or in some translations, a *lonely* place. But do they mean the same thing? To be *deserted* means to be uninhabited, empty; to be *lonely* means to be alone, without company. We can see how both of these could be good descriptions. And maybe these words also refer to the human condition and the deepest desires of the human heart.

The Gospels agree that Jesus was followed by a great crowd into the hill country. What were they after? Maybe some came to hear a little more about the kingdom, inspired by his hope-filled promise of God's mercy and healing. Perhaps others simply came to see another miracle from one whose words could change lives, and whose deeds could do marvelous things. Maybe some were at the last stop in their journey of life with nothing to lose and yet everything to gain.

So they are willing, if not eager, to follow him into this lonely/deserted place – willing to risk the growing darkness, hunger and even the potential of a long walk home just to be with Jesus. And it is here in this lonely/deserted place that Jesus meets them and their deepest needs in a life-abundant and self-giving way.

We are gathered today to celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi. In many ways, we are very like the Gospel crowd. We, too, have come with our hopes and needs to encounter Jesus. Here Jesus creates a Eucharistic world where all experience his real presence and the hope of something better – here no one goes hungry!

Today and at every Mass, Jesus meets these needs by giving us his total and unconditional love, while at the same time nourishing us both physically and spiritually. Here we see why the Church calls the Eucharist *the source and summit of our faith*. It is *source* because Jesus is the source of our faith, and it is *summit* as our faith is ultimately about a sharing in his Resurrection and life.

Here we truly receive the same Jesus – his body, blood, soul and divinity, nourishing us for those lonely moments that are so often part of our human experience, reassuring us that God is always present in our lives.

As we prepare to receive holy Communion, we will repeat the words of the centurion from the Gospel who encountered that same Jesus: *Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed* (Matthew 8:8). Every time we receive this great gift from heaven, we should do so with fear and trembling, knowing as Paul reminds us that we are proclaiming Christ's death and resurrection until he comes again in glory. Here we are joining the saints and angels in the worship of the One who has loved us without condition. Here in the signs of bread and wine, Christ meets our most basic needs: to be loved and to be nourished.

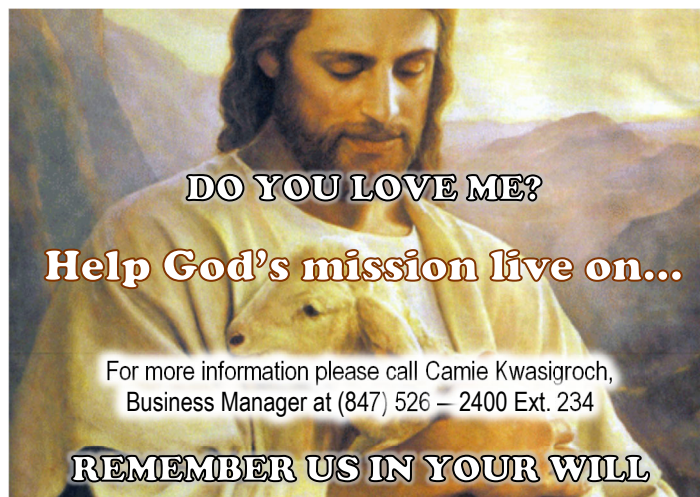

WHAT IF WE DO IT RIGHT...?

We have known for some time that it was coming. For years we have been hearing about, praying about, thinking about and talking about **Renew My Church**. A year ago we were informed that our **RMC grouping** had been altered and finalized: **Saint Mary of the Annunciation** (Mundelein), **Santa Maria del Popolo** (Mundelein), **Saint Frances de Sales** (Lake Zurich), **Transfiguration** (Wauconda) and **Frassati Catholic Academy** (Wauconda). However, we were still in the dark as to when something would happen with this grouping.

Well, the darkness gives way to the light. Our **Renew My Church** grouping is about to be **activated** (That's the word the Archdiocese uses for "something is happening"). While the letter from Cardinal Cupich proclaiming this is still a few weeks or a few months away, we pastors - **Father Jerome Jacob of Saint Mary of the Annunciation, Father Miguel Martinez of Santa Maria del Popolo, Father David Ryan of St. Francis de Sales, Father Juan Pablo of Transfiguration and Ms. Tammy Kleckner, Frassati Catholic Academy Principal** - have been informed that we are scheduled for activation in the spring 2020. We want to take this opportunity to share the news with you.

What exactly does this mean? Basically, before the year 2020 is out the four parishes, specifically, **RMC teams** from each parish, will begin to work on forming a configuration of what our communities will be in the future. The process will begin in its preliminary stage the spring and summer of 2020. During that time the pastors will go off on a short retreat to pray and share ideas about what is to come. Also, the **RMC parish teams** will be formed; the Archdiocese will provide some guidance on how to accomplish this. Then, a series of meetings will commence that will provide the forum for the shaping of our future vision and the means by which this vision can be brought to fulfillment. **The process is scheduled for completion by July 1, 2021.**

The first question many parishioners ask when being informed of this activation process is: "**Does this mean my parish is about to close?**" True, some parishes in the Archdiocese have closed or will need to close because of financial, structural, or personnel constraints. However, this practice of closures is **not** the goal of **Renew My Church**, and to see it as the inevitable conclusion of the process is unwarranted. At this moment, what the final configuration of our parishes will look like is known only in the mind of the Lord. It will be the work of the **RMC process** to discern what is in God's mind and how it can become reality for the good of the Church of Chicago.

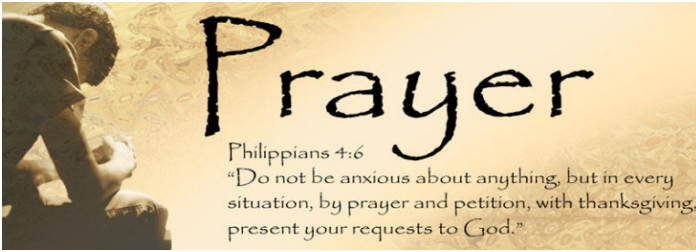
The process is sure to bring about some changes. Instead of approaching this process with apprehension, let's put our trust in the Spirit of Jesus who has guided the Church through schisms, scandals, social upheavals, financial downturns, and all sorts of difficulties, and who has never abandoned us. We have no reason to imagine that the Church formed at the cost of the shedding of Christ's blood will suddenly be left to its own devices, bereft of Divine intervention. **Rather than panic, we need to pray earnestly throughout this process to the Lord who companions us through every challenge and trial, trusting that His plan, not ours, will be accomplished.**

We priests are committed to work together with all of you, and to share with you what we hear from the Archdiocese throughout the **RMC process**. May we pray with and for all four of our parishes as we embrace this new experience of Church.

In the meantime, I want to invite all of you to come together and to use this coming months to remember the past with gratitude, to live the present with enthusiasm and to look forward to the future with confidence: **Renew My Church** calls each of us to face our challenges, and commit to a renewal of faith, active participation, engagement in a broader and more diverse family of families and, most importantly, to deepen our personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

To present the best of Transfiguration to the Archdiocese, **difficult decisions will have to be made**. But those considerations will be balanced by the more important questions: *How will this enable us to carry out Christ's mission in the communities we serve here in Transfiguration Parish? Why we think we could remain as Parish? How will this lead to Renewal?*

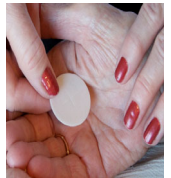

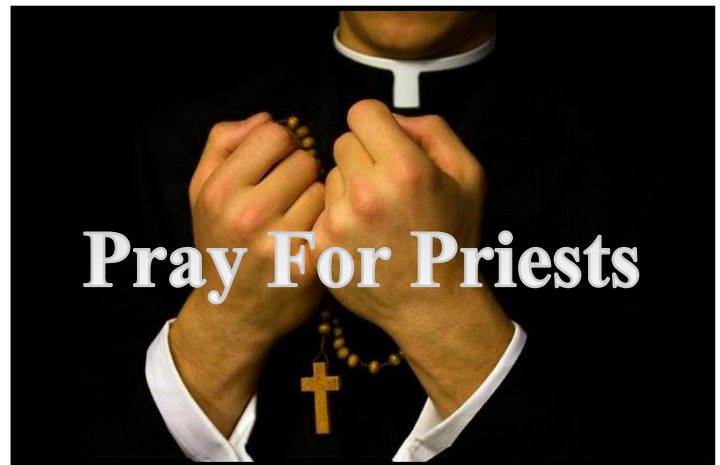
