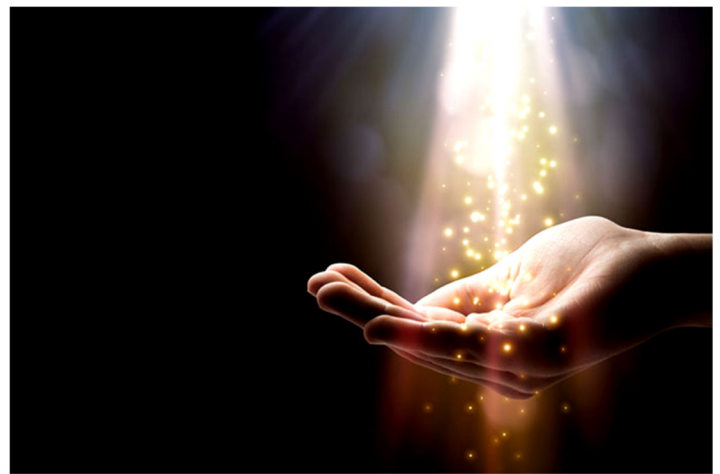

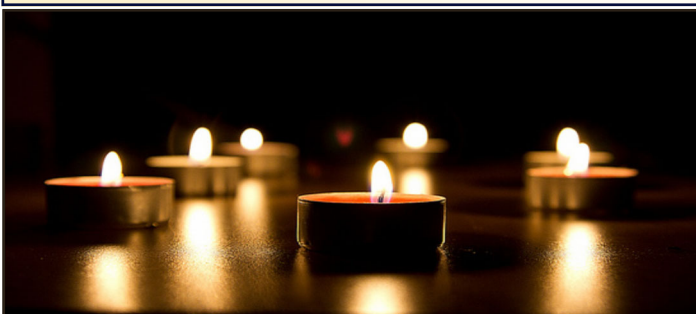

**LITURGY OF THE WORD**

**READING I — IS 66:10-14c**

Thus says the LORD:

Rejoice with Jerusalem and be glad because of her, all you who love her; exult, exult with her, all you who were mourning over her! Oh, that you may suck fully of the milk of her comfort, that you may nurse with delight at her abundant breasts!

For thus says the LORD:

Lo, I will spread prosperity over Jerusalem like a river, and the wealth of the nations like an overflowing torrent. As nurslings, you shall be carried in her arms, and fondled in her lap; as a mother comforts her child, so will I comfort you; in Jerusalem you shall find your comfort. When you see this, your heart shall rejoice and your bodies flourish like the grass; the LORD's power shall be known to his servants.

**READING II — GAL 6:14-18**

Brothers and sisters:

May I never boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, through which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. **GOSPEL — LK 10:1-12, 17-20**

At that time the Lord appointed seventy-two others whom he sent ahead of him in pairs to every town and place he intended to visit. He said to them, "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest. Go on your way; behold, I am sending you like lambs among wolves. Carry no money bag, no sack, no sandals; and greet no one along the way. Into whatever house you

enter, first say, 'Peace to this household.' If a peaceful person lives there, your peace will rest on him; but if not, it will return to you. Stay in the same house and eat and drink what is offered to you, for the laborer deserves his payment. Do not move about from one house to another. Whatever town you enter and they welcome you, eat what is set before you, cure the sick in it and say to them, 'The kingdom of God is at hand for you.' Whatever town you enter and they do not receive you, go out into the streets and say, 'The dust of your town that clings to our feet, even that we shake off against you.' Yet know this: the kingdom of God is at hand. I tell you, it will be more tolerable for Sodom on that day than for that town."

The seventy-two returned rejoicing, and said, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us because of your name." Jesus said, "I have observed Satan fall like lightning from the sky. Behold, I have given you the power to 'tread upon serpents' and scorpions and upon the full force of the enemy and nothing will harm you. Nevertheless, do not rejoice because the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice because your names are written in heaven."

## THE KINGDOM OF GOD IS AT HAND, AND THAT REQUIRES SOMETHING OF EVERYONE TO DO.

Jesus is God. He can do all things. Does he need the help of the seventy-two he sends out two by two in today's Gospel? No, and yes. No, because he saves the world all by himself. Yes, however, because he wants humanity to assist him in building the kingdom and bringing salvation to all humankind. He is setting in motion the building up of the Church that will take up the reins of leadership after he has ascended into heaven.

Jesus sends these men out to heal the sick, forgive sins, cast out demons and announce the kingdom of God. The harvest is plenty, the laborers are few. By chapter ten of Luke, which we heard from today, Jesus has already begun his final journey to Jerusalem – and to Calvary. Jesus knows his days are numbered, but the whole world must be touched by his message.

The chosen ones are told to travel lightly. All they can carry with them besides the clothing on their back is total trust in the providence of God to meet their needs. Hospitality would be the measure by which they would gauge the success or failure of their mission. Where God's word was welcomed, people would also welcome those who preached it. Likewise, where the Gospel was rejected, these disciples would shake the dust from their feet and move on to other towns. History shows acceptance and rejection from Jewish and Gentile communities alike.

The underlying truth of these instructions, it seems, is this: Whether people want to listen or not, regardless of whether they come to believe it or not, *the Kingdom of God is [in fact] at hand.* And this fact requires something of everyone – repentance and faith. Jesus has given the disciples power over *serpents and scorpions* – they have nothing to fear if they trust in the Lord. The same is true for all who believe.

Remember that Jesus said, *the harvest is abundant but the laborers are few.* The laborers are you and me. They are not some “other people.” So let's start the work of the kingdom today by traveling lightly, shedding the excess baggage of sin and worry, and depending on God to complete the great work he has begun in us.

Isaiah said, *The Lord's power shall be known to his servants.* This explains the unparalleled success of the early Church's first missionary excursion. From Jerusalem to the ends of the earth, all will experience the comfort and love of a merciful God thanks to the preaching of a chosen few.

## THE HEART OF THE MATTER: TIME FOR REFLECTION AND SPIRITUAL GROWTH

**Prayer:** Do I pray for the harvest? Do I pray to the Lord to send laborers to his harvest?

**Mission:** Do I labor in the harvest field?

**Message:** Do I proclaim the kingdom of God by my life and lips?

**Urgency:** Do I live and bear witness in light of eternity?

Lord, Jesus we ask you to send more servants to your people. Choose from our parishes, from our homes, from our schools and colleges, an abundant harvest of apostles for your Kingdom: priests, sisters, brothers, deacons and lay ministers. We pray that those you call may never lose awareness of the dignity and need of their vocation.

O Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church, teach to all those the Master calls to say a joyful “yes” as you did at the Annunciation. Amen.

## THE CALLING

If you're a serious Christian, you'll want to discover God's will for your life. This is the case when you face decisions about what to study, or where to live, or which career to choose. It's especially so when you face the challenge of discerning a lifelong commitment to marriage, or to consecrated life, or to priesthood.

For those discerning priesthood especially, the question of God's will for my life resonates strongly. Many often recount a sense of it being God's will that they become a priest, this quiet, persistent "nagging thought", or "tug in the heart" that leads them to join a seminary and discern more deeply.

If you're considering coming to the seminary, but not quite sure if you should, pray frequently (especially in Eucharistic Adoration), go to Mass (daily if you can) and regularly receive the sacrament of reconciliation. Get involved in your parish or local catholic community, with groups like St Vinnies or other kinds of outreach. If you have a spare two minutes, here's some great advice: by #AskBishopBarron
