ONE CHURCH — ONE MESSAGE:

ADVENT MESSAGE SERIES

Scripture: Luke 1:39-45

What does God want us to know? Say Yes to Relationships (Invest & Invite) Christianity is different from every other religion. Every other religion says we have to work our way to get to God. Christianity reveals it is the other way around.

What does God want us to do? To accept Salvation. **Salvation is about accepting Christ into your life, repeating the same yes Mary did, and receiving Christ into your life.** Ultimately, whatever other “yeses” you’ve got going on in your life, saying yes to Christ is your best yes. **Call someone and invited them to celebrate Christmas at Transfiguration.**

“Mary set out and traveled to the hill country in haste to a town of Judah, where she entered the house of Zechariah and greeted Elizabeth.” When Mary finds out she is pregnant with Jesus and that her cousin Elizabeth is also expecting, she goes to visit Elizabeth. She makes relationships a priority. **In this final week, we will look at the example of mother Mary and her preparation for the first Christmas. We are to make room for the most important relationships in our lives.** Like Elizabeth we are to express gratitude for those relationships. In this message we will look at identifying the most important relationships and how to grow in gratitude for them.






