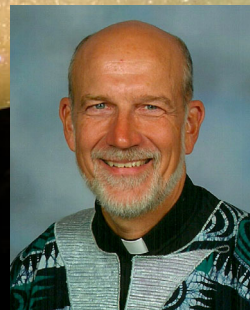

Why do you notice the splinter in your brother's eye, but do not perceive the wooden beam in your own? How can you say to your brother, 'Brother, let me remove that splinter in your eye,' when you do not even notice the wooden beam in your own eye? You hypocrite! Remove the wooden beam from your eye first; then you will see clearly to remove the splinter in your brother's eye. "A good tree does not bear rotten fruit, nor does a rotten tree bear good fruit. For every tree is known by its own fruit. For people do not pick figs from thorn bushes, nor do they gather grapes from brambles. ## LENT

A TIME OF REPENTANCE, GRACE & RENEWAL

Dear family of Transfiguration,

“To grant to those who mourn in Zion— to give them a beautiful headdress instead of ashes, the oil of gladness instead of mourning, the garment of praise instead of a faint spirit; that they may be called oaks of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, that he may be glorified.”— Isaiah 61: 3

A faint spirit, the oil of mourning, the ashes of grief—God promises to deliver us from these. What a blessing it is to serve a God who turns the sorrow of grief into a time of praise!

This coming Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, which marks the beginning of the Lenten season. On Ash Wednesday, we recall the biblical custom of covering ourselves in ashes. By doing this, we mark ourselves in two ways: as those who are in mourning for our crucified Christ, and as those who are filled with a heart of sorrow for their sins.

While our Advent celebrations are filled with joy as we remember the birth of our King, Lent is when we focus on the death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. Traditionally, the Church invites us to Fast, to Pray and to Give. Many of us choose to participate in some sort of fasting during this time—people have been known to fast from various foodstuffs as well as television and Internet usage. Others decided to study the Bible more closely or experience a time of solitude. Perhaps you will commit to attending services from now until the glory of Easter or dedicating a larger portion of your day to a time of prayer.

Whatever your personal preference, Lent can be the time when you decide to let go of old habits and develop a more joyful, Christ-filled way of living. I would like to invite you and your family to join me as we prepare for a time of tremendous spiritual growth and renewal.

Daylight Savings Time begins at 2:00 am next Sunday, March 10<sup>th</sup>. Set your clocks 1 hour **later** prior to retiring for the night on Saturday.

I am writing briefly to our entire community during this time to express appreciation for your **faithfulness** over the years in **generous giving to Transfiguration Parish**.

It is evident that **the Hand of God is upon this great community** as we look around and see obvious tangible evidence of his provision through the obedience of His people.

**Many of us can testify to the faithfulness of God in our own lives as we have given to the Lord** a Tithe of our income to our local parish. Numerous verses in the Old Testament refer to the practice of tithing. Jesus Himself in the New Testament told of the importance of tithing when He rebuked the Hypocritical Pharisees in Luke 11:42 – *But woe unto you, Pharisees! for ye tithe mint and rue and all manner of herbs, and pass over judgment and the love of God: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.*

This scripture makes it clear that even in the New Testament age, we are to consider judgment and the love of God, and not to leave the other “undone”. Christ clearly had opportunity to abolish the system of tithing, however, it is clear that He affirmed it.

Beyond this, anyone who has ever tithed as well as given offerings to the House of God can truly testify that God is faithful in supplying the needs for their own individual households. The Bible says in: Malachi 3:10 – *Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the Lord of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.*

Again, **we praise God for His faithfulness to Transfiguration**, and look forward to greater Ministry in the future.

## ABSTINENCE

The law of abstinence requires a Catholic 14 years of age until death to abstain from eating meat on Fridays in honor of the Passion of Jesus on Good Friday. **During Lent** abstinence from meat on Fridays is obligatory in the United States as elsewhere.

## FASTING

The law of fasting requires a Catholic from the 18th Birthday to the 59th Birthday to reduce the amount of food eaten from normal. The Church defines this as one meal a day, and two smaller meals which if added together would not exceed the main meal in quantity. Such fasting is obligatory on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. The fast is broken by eating between meals and by drinks which could be considered food (milk shakes, but not milk). Alcoholic beverages do not break the fast; however, they seem to be contrary to the spirit of doing penance.

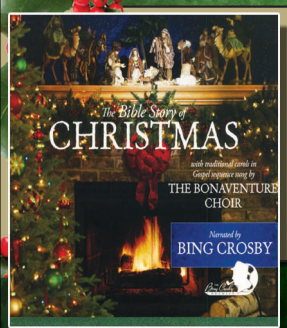
