

LITURGY-WINS

In addition to the parishioners who participate in the Board's planning and monthly meetings, there are many, many parish volunteers that enable the work of the Board: all our parish liturgical volunteers (sacristans, lectors, commentators, music ministers, ushers, ministers of hospitality, altar servers) and those that train them, those who maintain our church environments and altar linens.

Ongoing Activities:

- Working with site committees and schedulers of liturgical ministers so that all Masses have all the liturgical roles filled at each Mass.
- Training and catechesis of new liturgical ministers as they volunteer (altar servers, lectors, Eucharistic Ministers, etc.).

- Support the work of the parish Director of Liturgy and Music.


STEWARDSHIP—WINS

Major Activities This Period:

1. Church bathroom remodel. Most of the cost of this project was paid from bequests we received from the Paddock family, Theresa Solomini and the Vance Family.
2. Replaced carpets in 4 classrooms.
3. Replaced energy wasting lights with new LED lighting in Café.
4. Replaced air conditioning condenser for school office.
5. Painted and upgraded 8 classrooms.
6. Painted and upgraded 4 Restrooms in school.
7. Sanded and refinished gym floor. Project donated by Adam Brak and Family.
8. Replaced carpet and refinished hardwood floors in the rectory. Part of the labor was donated by Tom Burek and Family.
9. A life size Statue of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Donors and the Latino Ministry Commission helped to cover all the expenses.
10. One campus of FRASSATI CATHOLIC ACADEMY at our campus.

11. Security:

- March- trained 48 people including 18 police officers.
- June- trained all teachers and staff from Transfiguration and St. Mary's.
- July- trained ushers from 4 local churches in starting safety teams, dealing with medical issues and unruly people.






