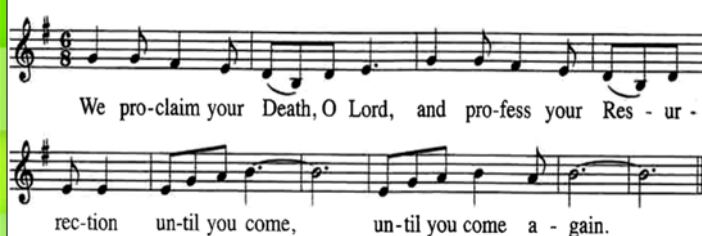

"For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven."

MATTHEW 5:20

The scribes and Pharisees lived according to the letter of the law and they used this to elevate themselves above the other people. Jesus is clear – it's the love that you have in your heart that will get you to heaven. Simply following church rules out of obligation, not love, does not put you on the path to heaven. Attending Mass on Sunday and then gossiping about a fellow parishioner on the parking lot is an example of a modern day Pharisee.

Taking a closer look at...

Part II of the Eucharistic Prayer

Today we look at the final moments within the Eucharistic Prayer of the Mass. In our last Mass moment, after having climbed Mount Calvary, we professed the mystery of faith. In this part II of the Eucharistic Prayer, the priest again calls upon the Holy Spirit. This time to conform US to the consecrated gifts. This sacrifice or offering of ourselves is not for the Father, but for OUR sakes – in the words of the priest, “Humbly we pray that, partaking of the Body and Blood of Christ, we may be gathered into one by the Holy Spirit.” The priest then offers a series of petitions within the heart of the Eucharistic Prayer. *Why now?* These serve as a tie that binds us. We pray for the pope, we pray for the local bishop and for people around the world. We pray for the souls in purgatory. The Eucharist links us to everybody else; not only in the church here below, around the world, but also the church above – the angels and saints, beginning with Mary and the Apostles. The Eucharistic Prayer ends with what is called the great doxology. This is a word of praise, directed to the Holy Trinity. When we receive something great it is right and proper to say thank you. When the priest holds up the elements in this moment – the body and the blood – he is offering them to the people with great praise to the Father. He offers them through, with and in Jesus Christ, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory and honor belonging to God forever. In this final moment of the Eucharistic Prayer, we respond with a great Amen! In that Amen our hearts sing - Yes -- Father, Son, and Holy Spirit -- we believe, we thank you, we praise you always!

Next week we will begin to look at the Communion Rite, as we prepare to answer the call to partake in full communion with Jesus and each other in our celebration of the Mass.

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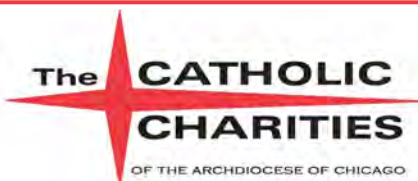
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
