



| PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Today's parable about the workers in the vineyard reminds me of a popular paraphrase of a famous Theodore Roosevelt quote, "Envy is the thief of joy." No matter how much or how little we have, we can find someone who appears better off or happier, or appears to have received more than they deserve. Take, for example, the vineyard workers in today's Gospel. Those who arrived first for work were upset and envious, because the last to arrive were the first to be paid – and they were paid the same wages as those who had been first to arrive. Envy robbed the all-day workers of joy: joy in a job well-done and being paid the just wage due to them; joy in celebrating the generosity of the landowner, and of living in the kingdom of heaven begun here on earth, content with and grateful for everything God has provided for each one of us. Although envy may indeed be the thief of joy, joy can be ours when we appreciate what we have and quit comparing ourselves to others. It also frees us to share our gifts and truly walk with others through the ups and downs of our lives as we work together in God's vineyard.

EVANGELIZE

| PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Today's parable has me thinking: When I feel envious of another's good fortune (sparkling clean house, teenaged boys who smile for photos), perhaps one way to counter that would be to talk through those feelings with God: "Help me be content with what I have. Thank you for the ways you have blessed my friends and me, and for the people in my life who hold me up in good times and bad." Just as the landowner was generous with the laborers, and God is immensely generous with us, let us make an effort this week to be generous in sharing the gifts in our lives with others. When we radiate gratitude and joy in our daily lives as Jesus' disciples, and let the Holy Spirit work through us in leading others to him, our witness to others will bear much fruit.

ACTION

Make a list of the gifts in our lives: Health, family, sparkly new earrings, a shiny lawn mower, you name it. Next, choose a "gift" you can share with others, and be specific: "I will make a card for Grandma today." "I will donate (fill in the blank) to the food and clothing pantry on Monday." "I will volunteer to be a greeter at Mass every other Sunday."



II. LITURGY OF THE WORD

(When saying 'Glory to you O Lord', with your thumb make a little sign of the cross on your forehead; then on your lips; then on your heart)

Jesus told his disciples this parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like a landowner who went out at dawn to hire laborers for his vineyard. After agreeing with them for the usual daily wage, he sent them into his vineyard. Going out about nine o'clock, the landowner saw others standing idle in the marketplace, and he said to them, 'You too go into my vineyard, and I will give you what is just.' So they went off. And he went out again around noon, and around three o'clock, and did likewise. Going out about five o'clock, the landowner found others standing around, and said to them, 'Why do you stand here idle all day?' They answered, 'Because no one has hired us.' He said to them, 'You too go into my vineyard.' When it was evening the owner of the vineyard said to his foreman, 'Summon the laborers and give them their pay, beginning with the last and ending with the first.' When those who had started about five o'clock came, each received the usual daily wage. So when the first came, they thought that they would receive more, but each of them also got the usual wage. And on receiving it they grumbled against the landowner, saying, 'These last ones worked only one hour, and you have made them equal to us, who bore the day's burden and the heat.' He said to one of them in reply, 'My friend, I am not cheating you. Did you not agree with me for the usual daily wage? Take what is yours and go. What if I wish to give this last one the same as you? Or am I not free to do as I wish with my own money? Are you envious because I am generous?' Thus, the last will be first, and the first will be last."

Lector: The Gospel of the Lord

HOMILY

PROFESSION OF FAITH

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.

I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

La parábola de hoy sobre los trabajadores del viñedo me recuerda una paráfrasis popular de una famosa cita de Theodore Roosevelt: "La envidia es la ladrona de la alegría". No importa cuánto o qué poco tengamos, podemos encontrar a alguien que parezca estar mejor o más feliz, o que parezca haber recibido más de lo que se merece. Tomemos, por ejemplo, a los trabajadores de la viña en el Evangelio de hoy. Los que llegaron primero a trabajar estaban molestos y envidiosos, porque los últimos en llegar eran los primeros en recibir el pago, y se les pagaba el mismo salario que a los primeros en llegar. La envidia les quitó la alegría a los que trabajan todo el día: alegría por un trabajo bien hecho y que se les pague el salario justo que les corresponde; gozo de celebrar la generosidad del terrateniente y de vivir en el reino de los cielos iniciado aquí en la tierra, contentos y agradecidos por todo lo que Dios ha provisto para cada uno de nosotros. Si bien la envidia puede ser la ladrona del gozo, el gozo puede ser nuestro cuando apreciamos lo que tenemos y dejamos de compararnos con los demás. También nos libera para compartir nuestros dones y caminar verdaderamente con otros a través de los altibajos de nuestras vidas mientras trabajamos juntos en la viña de Dios.






