## AS A DISCIPLE

| PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

I took up distance running some years ago, thanks largely to a group of friends who encouraged me along the way. We'd share the peaks and valleys of our lives as we tackled rolling hills. Those long runs come to mind when I hear Paul give thanks to the Thessalonians for having "endurance in hope of our Lord Jesus Christ." Paul here speaks of hope in Jesus -- a hope that has the risen Christ as its foundation, and is central to the Christian life. When I think of what lies at the end of a long run, such as water and blissful rest, and how grateful I am for these simple pleasures, I cannot help but rejoice in the hope that St. Paul refers to today. Our catechism makes it clear: "We firmly believe, and hence we hope that, just as Christ is truly risen from the dead and lives forever, so after death the righteous will live forever with the risen Christ and he will raise them up on the last day." (989)

## EVANGELIZE

| PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

During a particularly challenging time, I confided in a close friend over the phone. She didn't just offer to pray for me, she actually prayed with me on that phone call. I don't recall her exact words, but she called on Jesus to help me trust that God would see me through. So often, it can be hard to find the words to encourage others in their faith. When that happens, why not bring Jesus into the conversation? It may seem awkward at first, but offering to pray with another person in real time can be a powerful witness and encouragement. As Christians, we don't rely on "hoping" that everything will work out in the end; instead, we know that our hope is in Christ Jesus. As the catechism says: "Hope is the theological virtue by which we desire the kingdom of heaven and eternal life as our happiness." (1817) It doesn't get much more direct than that. Reflect on what "hope" looks like for us as Christians. And then tell a friend about it.

Did you Know?


The source of our second reading today, the First Letter from Paul to the Thessalonians, contains the earliest mention within Christian literature of the three theological virtues: "faith, hope and love." Reread today's passage, and then read 1 Thessalonians 5:5-8. In prayer, we can ask God to help us grow in all three virtues and show us ways to share them with others.

He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets.



## CRECER

### COMO DISCIPULOS

| ORAMOS, ESTUDIAMOS, SERVIMOS

Empecé a correr a distancia hace algunos años, en gran parte gracias a un grupo de amigos que me animaron en el camino. Compartiríamos los picos y los valles de nuestras vidas al abordar las colinas. Me vienen a la mente esos largos recorridos cuando escucho a Pablo dar gracias a los tesalonicenses por tener "paciencia en la esperanza de nuestro Señor Jesucristo". Pablo habla aquí de la esperanza en Jesús, una esperanza que tiene como fundamento a Cristo resucitado y es fundamental para la vida cristiana. Cuando pienso en lo que hay al final de una carrera larga, como el agua y el descanso feliz, y lo agradecido que estoy por estos placeres simples, no puedo evitar alegrarme en la esperanza a la que se refiere San Pablo hoy. Nuestro catecismo lo deja claro: "Creemos firmemente, y por eso esperamos que, así como Cristo verdaderamente ha resucitado de entre los muertos y vive para siempre, así los justos vivirán para siempre con Cristo resucitado después de la muerte y él los resucitará sobre el último día." ## MISION

### EVANGELIZAMOS

| ORANDO, DANDO TESTIMONIO, ACOMPAÑANDO

Durante un momento particularmente desafiante, le conté a un amigo cercano por teléfono. Ella no solo se ofreció a orar por mí, en realidad oró conmigo en esa llamada telefónica. No recuerdo sus palabras exactas, pero le pidió a Jesús que me ayudara a confiar en que Dios me ayudaría. Muy a menudo, puede ser difícil encontrar las palabras para animar a otros en su fe. Cuando eso sucede, ¿por qué no traer a Jesús a la conversación? Puede parecer incómodo al principio, pero ofrecerse a orar con otra persona en tiempo real puede ser un testimonio poderoso y un estímulo. Como cristianos, no confiamos en "esperar" que todo salga bien al final; en cambio, sabemos que nuestra esperanza está en Cristo Jesús. Como dice el catecismo: "La esperanza es la virtud teológica por la que deseamos el reino de los cielos y la vida eterna como nuestra felicidad". (1817) No hay nada más directo que eso. Reflexione sobre cómo se ve la "esperanza" para nosotros como cristianos. Y luego cuéntaselo a un amigo.






