When we look at the world, we see evil and injustice. Bad things happen to good people and good things happen to bad people. Why does an all-good and all-powerful God, allow injustice to happen? Why doesn't he stop it? Why does God seem to be silent on prayers he should answer while answering prayers that seem insignificant? If we were God we would certainly run the world differently.

These questions are nothing new, but were experienced by many people in the bible. In this series, we will look at some of God's ways that don't seem to make sense. We'll examine what to do in the face of such questions and look at ways we can grow to understand God's perspective.

WEEK TWO : Suffering/Pain/Injustice

Scripture: 2 Timothy 1:8-10

What does God want us to know? Suffering is a part of life and God can use it for our growth.

What does God want us to do? Decide that when you are going through a period of suffering or injustice (lost job, illness, teenage child rebelling) that God might be using it to grow your faith. Instead of praying for the thorn to be removed, pray that God will use it.

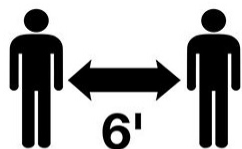
God's original design for the world was good and operated without suffering and injustice. When sin entered, so did suffering. This was not part of God's original plan. God does not cause suffering, but allows it and can use it for our growth. The transfiguration occurred shortly after Peter first confessed that Jesus was indeed the Messiah and that he would suffer and die. The close connection between the transfiguration and Peter's confession is significant – the Messiah must suffer but glorification, not suffering, is his ultimate fate. This was reassurance for the disciples to see Jesus “changed” and “glorified” as they contemplated what was about to happen to Jesus and to them (a future of suffering for Christ). We are also expected to endure some suffering for Christ as Paul says in today's second reading.

2ª SEMANA: Sufrimiento / Dolor / Injusticia

Escritura: 2 Timoteo 1, 8-10

¿Qué quiere Dios que sepamos? El sufrimiento hace parte de la vida y Dios dispone de este para nuestro crecimiento. .

¿Qué quiere Dios que hagamos? Considera que Dios aprovechará el sufrimiento para que crezcas en la fe cuando tengas que pasar por algún momento difícil e injusto (pérdida de un trabajo, un hijo adolescente rebelde, etc.). En vez de orar para que Dios remueva la espina, ora para que Dios la use.

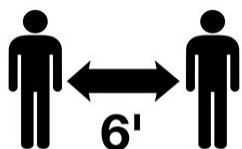
El plan original de Dios era un mundo bondadoso, sin sufrimientos, ni injusticias; el sufrimiento entró hasta que el pecado llegó, por lo tanto, este no estaba en el plan original de Dios. Aunque Dios no es el autor del sufrimiento, si lo permite para que crezcamos. El evento de la Transfiguración sucedió justo después de que Pedro profesara a Jesús como el mesías verdadero y el consecuente anuncio de su sufrimiento y muerte. Por lo tanto, esta conexión es importante entre la transfiguración y la profesión de Pedro – el mesías va a sufrir pero la gloria tendrá la última palabra. Este evento sirvió de afirmación a los discípulos de que lo que contemplaron, ver a Jesús cambiar y glorificado, sería algo que sucedería tanto a Jesús como a todos ellos. Tal y como lo dice San Pablo en la segunda lectura hoy, debemos disponernos a sufrir por Cristo.

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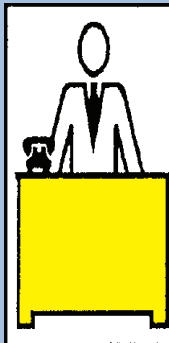
