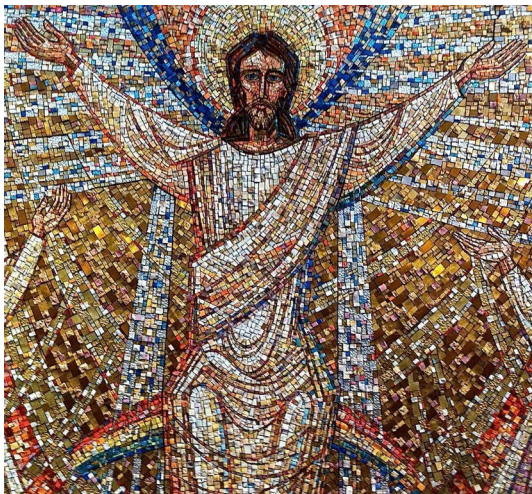

AS A DISCIPLE

| PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

It takes only a few moments of holding one's breath to realize how desperately we need oxygen to survive. If only we were always as cognizant and mindful of the importance of the Eucharist for the same reason! I, for one, confess to approaching the altar with fervent belief in the body, blood, soul, and divinity of Christ, but also at times doing so while distracted or not fully appreciative of the gift being given to me. But today's solemnity is a powerful reminder not to take the Eucharist for granted. It is the Church's formal and official homage to Jesus Christ who, "with his own blood" obtained for us eternal redemption. St. Thomas Aquinas offers this description of how wonderful, precious, and important the Eucharist is with the following words: "The only-begotten Son of God, wishing to enable us to share in his divinity, assumed our nature, so that by becoming man he might make us gods." (Opusc. 57, 1-4) Like the disciples on the night of the Last Supper, we, too, receive the body and blood of Jesus under the appearance of bread and wine. He dwells within us, intercedes for us, and through grace he transforms us.

| PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

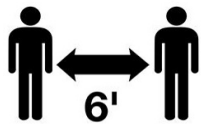
Spending time with our Lord at Eucharistic adoration is a profound opportunity to open our hearts to him. Just as we know that we cannot love others well if we don't love ourselves, likewise we cannot share the love of Christ with others well if we don't take time to allow Christ to enter our hearts and our lives. By taking the time to talk to Jesus and listen, we can, in turn, witness to his love to others. We can use this time to pray for a specific person, seek help with a personal dilemma, or ask the Lord to show us where we need repentance and conversion in our own lives so as to be more like him. The more we are conformed to Christ, the better we can bring Christ to the world.

O God, who in this wonderful Sacrament have left us a memorial of your Passion, grant us, we pray, so to revere the sacred mysteries of your Body and Blood that we may always experience in ourselves the fruits of your redemption. II. LITURGY OF THE WORD

A reading from the Book of Exodus

—Ex 24:3-8

When Moses came to the people and related all the words and ordinances of the LORD, they all answered with one voice, "We will do everything that the LORD has told us." Moses then wrote down all the words of the LORD and, rising early the next day, he erected at the foot of the mountain an altar and twelve pillars for the twelve tribes of Israel. Then, having sent certain young men of the Israelites to offer holocausts and sacrifice young bulls as peace offerings to the LORD, Moses took half of the blood and put it in large bowls; the other half he splashed on the altar. Taking the book of the covenant, he read it aloud to the people, who answered, "All that the LORD has said, we will heed and do." Then he took the blood and sprinkled it on the people, saying, "This is the blood of the covenant that the LORD has made with you in accordance with all these words of his."

Lector: Word of the Lord

Assembly: Thanks be to God.

Responsorial Psalm

R: "Our blessing-cup is a communion with the Blood of Christ the Lord."

A reading from the Letter to the Hebrews

— Heb 9:11-15

Brothers and sisters: When Christ came as high priest of the good things that have come to be, passing through the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made by hands, that is, not belonging to this creation, he entered once for all into the sanctuary, not with the blood of goats and calves but with his own blood, thus obtaining eternal redemption. For if the blood of goats and bulls and the sprinkling of a heifer's ashes can sanctify those who are defiled so that their flesh is cleansed, how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from dead works to worship the living God. For this reason he is mediator of a new covenant: since a death has taken place for deliverance from transgressions under the first covenant, those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance.

On the first day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread, when they sacrificed the Passover lamb, Jesus' disciples said to him, "Where do you want us to go and prepare for you to eat the Passover?" He sent two of his disciples and said to them, "Go into the city and a man will meet you, carrying a jar of water. Follow him. Wherever he enters, say to the master of the house, 'The Teacher says, "Where is my guest room where I may eat the Passover with my disciples?"' Then he will show you a large upper room furnished and ready. Make the preparations for us there." The disciples then went off, entered the city, and found it just as he had told them; and they prepared the Passover. While they were eating, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, gave it to them, and said, "Take it; this is my body." Then he took a cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them, and they all drank from it. He said to them, "This is my blood of the covenant, which will be shed for many. Amen, I say to you, I shall not drink again the fruit of the vine until the day when I drink it new in the kingdom of God." Then, after singing a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives.

HOMILY

PROFESSION OF FAITH

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.

I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made. For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven, and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets.

I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen

MISSION STATEMENT: The ministry of hospitality that we exercise at the Eucharist is the liturgical enactment of the hospitality that permeates our daily living. Hospitality is not an add-on; for the Christian, it is the bottom line: "Then the king will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father. Inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, a stranger and you welcomed me.'" (Mt. 25:34 – 35)

TALENTS NEEDED: Ministers of Hospitality are the community's way of greeting everyone who walks through our church doors. Such ministers try to make everyone who enters our worship space feel at ease so they can fully participate in liturgical prayer. In addition to offering welcome, Ministers of Hospitality also direct and assist people during communion, maintain an orderly environment, provide adequate seating, help with the collection, distribute bulletins and assist with emergencies.

QUALIFICATIONS: A sense of liturgical prayer; a gift of hospitality; a warm smile; a desire to see that those who pray at Transfiguration feel welcomed; and ability to stay calm in the face of emergencies and good communication skills. Those interested in this ministry attend a session, which examines the role of hospitality in liturgy and teaches the hands-on aspects of ministry.

LEVEL OF COMMITMENT: Ministers are expected to serve when scheduled and get their own substitutes when necessary. They minister at the weekend liturgies, holy days of obligation and special liturgies. They are also expected to attend community building evenings, which include scripture reflection and faith sharing as well as opportunities for camaraderie and ministry updates.

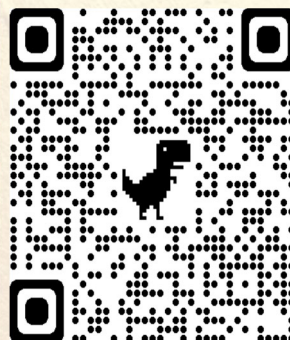

COMO DISCIPULOS

| ORAMOS, ESTUDIAMOS, SERVIMOS

Solo se necesitan unos momentos de contener la respiración para darse cuenta de cuán desesperadamente necesitamos oxígeno para sobrevivir. ¡Si tan solo fuéramos siempre tan conscientes y conscientes de la importancia de la Eucaristía por la misma razón! Yo, por mi parte, confieso que me acerco al altar con una fe ferviente en el cuerpo, la sangre, el alma y la divinidad de Cristo, pero también a veces lo hago mientras estoy distraído o sin apreciar plenamente el regalo que se me ha dado. Pero la solemnidad de hoy es un poderoso recordatorio de no dar por sentada la Eucaristía. Es el homenaje formal y oficial de la Iglesia a Jesucristo, quien "con su propia sangre" obtuvo para nosotros la redención eterna. Santo Tomás de Aquino ofrece esta descripción de lo maravillosa, preciosa e importante que es la Eucaristía con las siguientes palabras: "El unigénito Hijo de Dios, deseando hacernos participar de su divinidad, asumió nuestra naturaleza, de modo que al convertirse en hombre, podría convertirnos en dioses ". (Opusc. 57, 1-4) Como los discípulos en la noche de la Última Cena, nosotros también recibimos el cuerpo y la sangre de Jesús bajo la apariencia de pan y vino. 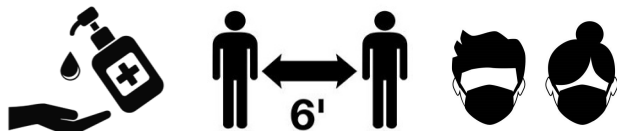

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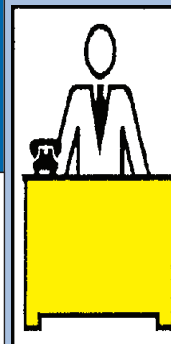
