

GROW

AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

I'm struck by phrases in today's first and second readings: The prophet Ezekiel is told that those to whom he will be sent are "hard of face and obstinate of heart"; and Saint Paul aptly describes a "thorn in the flesh" as having been given to him. He even refers to this thorn as "an angel of Satan." These are descriptive images! So, I wondered, What do these images look like in practice? The Gospel gives us a clear example: those who grew up with Jesus refuse to see him as a prophet. At one time in my life, I might have said to myself: "Wow, I can't believe people of his own time would reject Jesus!" However, as I grow older, I'm conscious not only of more physical aches and pains, but the "thorn in the flesh" of patterns I'm not particularly proud of – cynicism, pessimism, even hard-heartedness and a closed mind. The "they" in today's readings hits closer to home and strikes me more as "we" than it used to. And yet, as Saint Paul reminds us, we can bring our imperfections to God and pray for grace to give us strength in our weakness, hearts open to God's love, and ears ready to hear the Gospel and be transformed by Jesus.


EVANGELIZE

|PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

When Jesus returned to his hometown, he was not exactly greeted like a "hometown hero." His contemporaries could see him only as a carpenter, and not the Messiah: "So he was not able to perform any mighty deed there, apart from curing a few sick people by laying his hands on them. He was amazed at their lack of faith." We know that Jesus went on to perform the mightiest of deeds – dying and rising from the dead. And yet, even today, he would be "amazed at our lack of faith." Today's Gospel and the other readings encourage us to do a check-up of our spiritual health and pray for the grace to continue to grow in faith. We can also pray for others who may be questioning or have lost their faith, inviting them to consider coming to church with us or simply offering to pray with and for them.

REFLECT

For a more intentional look at whatever thorns might be in your side, and what weaknesses those contribute to, consider doing a retreat. Attend an in-person retreat at a local retreat house, or look into online options for a guided retreat at home. You offer to pray for someone, drop everything and do it!

Me impresionan las frases de la primera y segunda lectura de hoy: Al profeta Ezequiel se le dice que aquellos a quienes será enviado son "de rostro duro y obstinado de corazón"; y San Pablo describe acertadamente un "agujón en la carne" que le fue entregado. Incluso se refiere a esta espina como "un ángel de Satanás". ¡Estas son imágenes descriptivas! Entonces, me pregunté, ¿cómo se ven estas imágenes en la práctica? El Evangelio nos da un claro ejemplo: los que crecieron con Jesús se niegan a verlo como profeta. En un momento de mi vida, podría haberme dicho a mí mismo: "¡Vaya, no puedo creer que la gente de su época rechazara a Jesús!" Sin embargo, a medida que envejezco, soy consciente no solo de más dolores y molestias físicas, sino también de la "espina en la carne" de los patrones de los que no estoy particularmente orgulloso: cinismo, pesimismo, incluso dureza de corazón y una mente cerrada. . El "ellos" en las lecturas de hoy golpea más cerca de casa y me parece más como "nosotros" que antes. Y sin embargo, como nos recuerda San Pablo, podemos llevar nuestras imperfecciones a Dios y orar para que la gracia nos dé fuerza en nuestra debilidad, corazones abiertos al amor de Dios y oídos listos para escuchar el Evangelio y ser transformados por Jesús.

Cuando Jesús regresó a su ciudad natal, no fue recibido exactamente como un "héroe de la ciudad natal". Sus contemporáneos solo podían verlo como un carpintero, y no como el Mesías: "Así que no pudo realizar ninguna obra poderosa allí, aparte de curar a unos pocos enfermos imponiéndoles las manos. Estaba asombrado de su falta de fe ". Sabemos que Jesús pasó a realizar las obras más poderosas: morir y resucitar de entre los muertos. Y sin embargo, incluso hoy, estaría "asombrado por nuestra falta de fe". El Evangelio de hoy y las demás lecturas nos animan a hacer un chequeo de nuestra salud espiritual y a orar por la gracia de seguir creciendo en la fe. También podemos orar por otros que puedan estar cuestionando o hayan perdido su fe, invitándolos a considerar venir a la iglesia con nosotros o simplemente ofreciéndose a orar con y por ellos.


