



“Ephphatha!”

Twenty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time

Is 35:4-7a || Jas 2:1-5 || Mk 7:31-37

GROW

AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Our oldest son is deaf. I vividly remember watching him notice sounds for the first time in the days after his cochlear implant was activated: the “caw” of a crow, a doorbell, the low rumble of the furnace kicking in. Our job as parents was to provide a running commentary to help him understand the meaning of each sound that so many of us take for granted: “See the birds? That is a crow!” “Your dad is home.” “The heat is coming on.” I’m reminded of those early days when I read Mark’s account of Jesus restoring hearing to the deaf man. While most of us can hear, so often we take the sounds all around us for granted or relegate them to background noise – including the Scripture we hear at Mass each week. As Bishop Robert Barron writes, “This deaf man stands for all of us who do not hear the word of God, who have grown oblivious to it.” As we listen to today’s readings, we can ask Jesus to open our ears and our hearts to the word of God.

GO

EVANGELIZE | PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Mark spares no detail in describing Jesus’ encounter with the deaf man who had a speech impediment. Jesus places a finger in his ear and spits, touching his tongue, then utters the word “Ephphatha! (“Be opened”) Immediately, the man can hear and speak clearly. When listening to this reading, I often focus on the man’s hearing. But Jesus also cured the man’s speech impediment, which I think indicates we’re not supposed to just hear God’s word, we are to speak to it, and speak of it. Once we allow Jesus to open our ears and hearts to the Good News, sharing it will begin to come naturally. There may still be times when our Catholic tongues feel tied, but “Be strong, fear not!” Jesus will give us the words.

ACTIONS

Next time you take a drive, listen to the day’s Scripture readings. Ask Jesus to open your ears and hearts to his words and show you how best to share them with others.

And most teachers would agree: The more senses we engage, the more we take in. If you have trouble following the readings at Mass, open your missalette and read along silently.

The RCIA Process Stages

DISCERNMENT: the initial period before you decide to enter the Catholic Church. You're asking questions and checking it out, but aren't yet ready to commit.

LEARNING: in this stage, you're developing your faith and are being "catechized"- learning the basic points about Catholic faith and life.

PREPARATION: the church will help you focus and intensify your faith as you prepare you to commit your life to Christ. You'll go through a beautiful series of Gospels-based meditations during Lent.

INITIATION: itself, is the culmination of the whole process! You're received into the Church during the Easter Vigil Mass, where you'll receive the sacraments in initiation: baptism, confirmation, and Eucharist.

STRENGTH: after reception into the Church at Easter, this period lets you reflect and learn more about the mysteries of the Mass and the Sacraments that you now participate in fully.

Nuestro hijo mayor es sordo. Recuerdo vívidamente haberlo visto notar sonidos por primera vez en los días posteriores a la activación de su implante coclear: el "graznido" de un cuervo, el timbre de la puerta, el ruido sordo de la caldera entrando. Nuestro trabajo como padres era proporcionar un comentario para ayudarlo a comprender el significado de cada sonido que muchos de nosotros damos por sentado: "¿Ves los pájaros? ¡Eso es un cuervo! " "Tu papá está en casa". "Se acerca el calor". Recuerdo aquellos primeros días cuando leí el relato de Marcos sobre cómo Jesús restauró la audición al sordo. Si bien la mayoría de nosotros puede escuchar, a menudo damos por sentado los sonidos que nos rodean o los relegamos al ruido de fondo, incluida la Escritura que escuchamos en la Misa cada semana. Como escribe el obispo Robert Barron: "Este sordo representa a todos los que no escuchamos la palabra de Dios, que nos hemos olvidado de ella". Al escuchar las lecturas de hoy, podemos pedirle a Jesús que abra nuestros oídos y nuestro corazón a la palabra de Dios.

EVANGELIZAMOS

| ORANDO, DANDO TESTIMONIO, ACOMPAÑANDO

Marcos no escatima en detalles al describir el encuentro de Jesús con el hombre sordo que tenía un impedimento del habla. Jesús coloca un dedo en su oído y escupe, tocándose la lengua, luego pronuncia la palabra "¡Effetá! ("Se abre") Inmediatamente, el hombre puede oír y hablar con claridad. Cuando escucho esta lectura, a menudo me concentro en la audición del hombre. Pero Jesús también curó el impedimento del habla del hombre, lo que creo que indica que no se supone que solo escuchemos la palabra de Dios, debemos hablarle y hablar de ella. Una vez que permitamos que Jesús abra nuestros oídos y corazones a las Buenas Nuevas, compartirlas comenzará a ser algo natural. Puede que todavía haya ocasiones en las que nuestras lenguas católicas se sientan atadas, pero "¡Sé fuerte, no temas!" Jesús nos dará las palabras.

ACCIONES:

La próxima vez que conduzca, escuche las lecturas bíblicas del día. Pídale a Jesús que abra sus oídos y corazones a sus palabras y le muestre la mejor manera de compartirlas con los demás.

Y la mayoría de los maestros estarían de acuerdo: cuantos más sentidos involucramos, más asimilamos. Si tiene problemas para seguir las lecturas en la misa, abra su misal y lea en silencio.




