AS A DISCIPLE

| PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Today's graphic Gospel passage always sounds a bit jarring: "If your hand causes you to sin, cut it off." Upon first reading that passage, our response might be, "What?" But upon further reflection, it strikes me that Jesus is challenging us to attend to what causes us to sin: the vices we have acquired, the temptations we do not ignore, the sinful thoughts and behaviors we entertain or in which we engage. It is also important to identify where we might be culpable in leading others astray. In all of this, Jesus is asking us to be honest with ourselves and to take the necessary steps to "cut" out of our lives the things that lead us away from the Lord, rather than allowing us to move toward him. Lest we get discouraged, we need only remember that we are not alone: We belong to Christ whose word is truth, whose precepts "give joy to the heart," and who tells us "whoever is not against us is for us." Like Moses in the first reading, we can ask that the Spirit descend upon us and give us strength.

EVANGELIZE

| PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Amazing feats we see on TV or read in the news can't help but capture our imagination. Our rich Catholic faith can be a little like that: just take a look at the lives of the saints. That's why I find the other passage in today's Gospel so encouraging. Jesus reminds us that even the smallest things we do matter —actions to help others grow in their faith: "Anyone who gives you a cup of water to drink because you belong to Christ, amen, I say to you, will surely not lose his reward." As the Lord's spirit moves us to be a prophet to others — that is, to perform deeds in his name (mighty or not-so-mighty) — we have the ability to witness the Gospel of Jesus Christ in very real and concrete ways. As St. Teresa of Ávila said: "Accustom yourself continually to make many acts of love, for they enkindle and melt the soul."

ACTIONS

Prepare for the sacrament of reconciliation by asking Jesus to help you identify what causes you to sin or drives a wedge between you and others or between you and God. Then participate in this beautiful sacrament and pray for the grace to make changes.

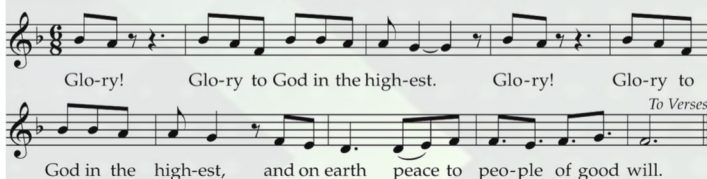

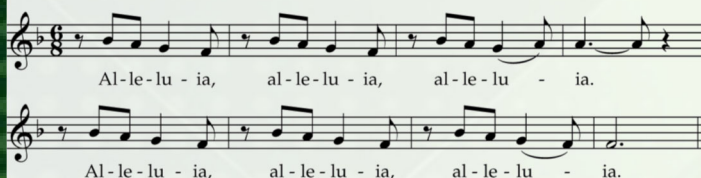

At that time, John said to Jesus, "Teacher, we saw someone driving out demons in your name, and we tried to prevent him because he does not follow us." Jesus replied, "Do not prevent him. There is no one who performs a mighty deed in my name who can at the same time speak ill of me. For whoever is not against us is for us. 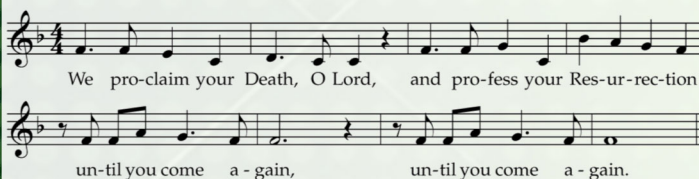

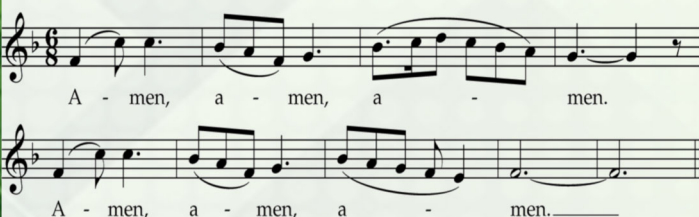

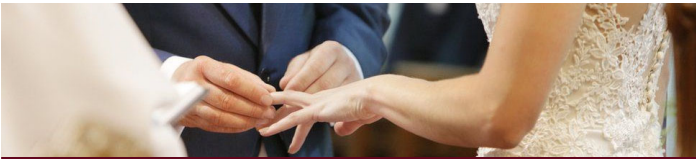

COMO DISCIPULOS

| **ORAMOS, ESTUDIAMOS, SERVIMOS**

El pasaje del Evangelio de hoy siempre suena un poco discordante: "Si tu mano te hace pecar, córtatela". Al leer ese pasaje por primera vez, nuestra respuesta podría ser: "¿Qué?" Pero después de una reflexión más profunda, me sorprende que Jesús nos esté desafiando a que prestemos atención a lo que nos hace pecar: los vicios que hemos adquirido, las tentaciones que no ignoramos, los pensamientos y comportamientos pecaminosos que tenemos o en los que nos involucramos. También es importante identificar dónde podríamos ser culpables al desviar a otros. En todo esto, Jesús nos pide que seamos honestos con nosotros mismos y que demos los pasos necesarios para "cortar" de nuestras vidas las cosas que nos alejan del Señor, en lugar de permitirnos acercarnos a él. Para no desanimarnos, basta recordar que no estamos solos: pertenecemos a Cristo, cuya palabra es verdad, cuyos preceptos "alegran el corazón", y que nos dice "el que no está contra nosotros, por nosotros es". Como Moisés en la primera lectura, podemos pedir que el Espíritu descienda sobre nosotros y nos dé fuerzas.

| **ORANDO, DANDO TESTIMONIO, ACOMPAÑANDO**

Las hazañas asombrosas que vemos en la televisión o leemos en las noticias no pueden evitar capturar nuestra imaginación. Nuestra rica fe católica puede ser un poco así: basta con echar un vistazo a la vida de los santos. Por eso encuentro tan alentador el otro pasaje del Evangelio de hoy. Jesús nos recuerda que incluso las cosas más pequeñas que hacemos importan, las acciones para ayudar a otros a crecer en su fe: "Cualquiera que les dé un vaso de agua para beber porque pertenecen a Cristo, amén, les digo, seguramente no perderá el suyo. recompensa." 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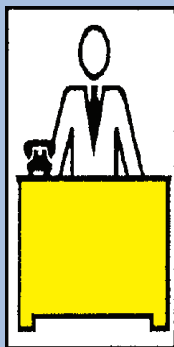
