WEEK TWO: They are coming: Obstacles to growing in Gratitude.

Scripture: Luke 21: 25-28, 34-36

How does God want us to feel? Confident that gratitude and thankfulness will help you face the anxieties of life.

What does God want us to know? Life brings trials and tribulations on a daily basis but prayer of gratitude slows us down to face those trials with peace rather than anxiety.

What does God want us to do? As part of your prayer, thank God every day for three things you are grateful for over the last twenty four hours.

In the Gospel, Jesus warns of tribulations that are coming. Every day we experience troubles and tribulations – they are coming. Jesus tells us not to get sucked into them or allow the anxieties of life to overwhelm us. Instead he says to pray. **Prayer of gratitude and thanksgiving helps us to slow down and get a larger view of our lives.** Trials and tribulations are coming but if we have an attitude of gratitude we will be better prepared to face them .


