Scripture: Exodus 3:1-8a, 13-15

From government to the class room to the ball field to church, we have experiences of the wrong people being in charge. We encounter leaders who are incompetent, corrupt or worse. In this message we will look at the call of Moses and what it says about God's view of bad leaders.

What does God want us to know? God sees bad leadership and wants to lead us out of it. He calls on his people to step up into leadership.

What does God want us to do? Pray for the guidance to see how God is leading us away from bad leadership to a broader place. Ask God if he is calling us into leadership.

What does God want us to feel? Encouraged that God does not want us to experience bad leadership. Challenged to step up.

So Moses decided, "I must go over to look at this remarkable sight, and see why the bush is not burned." When the LORD saw him coming over to look at it more closely, God called out to him from the bush, "Moses! Moses!" He answered, "Here I am." God said, "Come no nearer! Remove the sandals from your feet, for the place where you stand is holy ground. I am the God of your fathers," he continued, "the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, the God of Jacob." Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look at God. But the LORD said, "I have witnessed the affliction of my people in Egypt and have heard their cry of complaint against their slave drivers, so I know well what they are suffering. Therefore I have come down to rescue them from the hands of the Egyptians and lead them out of that land into a good and spacious land, a land flowing with milk and honey." Moses said to God, "But when I go to the Israelites and say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you,' if they ask me, 'What is his name?' what am I to tell them?" God replied, "I am who am." Then he added, "This is what you shall tell the Israelites: I AM sent me to you." God spoke further to Moses, "Thus shall you say to the Israelites: The LORD, the God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, the God of Jacob, has sent me to you. This is my name forever; thus am I to be remembered through all generations."




