How can I lead a deeper, more purposeful life as a follower of Jesus?

Catholic Atheist is about the many ways we profess to believe God, but then by our thoughts or actions show that we don't really trust him or act as if he exists. **Throughout the series we will look at five specific ways in which we profess God, but then act and think as if he doesn't exist.**

Week Four:

WE BELIEVE IN GOD, but don't know him.

Scripture: John 9: 1 – 41

What does God want us to know? Our God is not a concept or an idea but a personal God. God wants us to know him and wants to reveal himself to us.

What does God want us to do? We are invited to personally know God and be his intimate friends and allies. We have to choose though to admit our ignorance, express a desire for him, listen to him and to leave space for him.

The Gospel contrasts the faith of the man born blind with the willful blindness of the religious leaders. The religious leaders were supposed to be able to identify the Messiah and yet they failed to recognize him. They don't know him. In this week, we will look at ways we choose to be ignorant of God and how to follow the example of the man born blind so that we truly know our Savior.

As Jesus passed by he saw a man blind from birth. He spat on the ground and made clay with the saliva, and smeared the clay on his eyes, and said to him, "Go wash in the Pool of Siloam" — which means Sent —. So he went and washed, and came back able to see.

But others said, "How can a sinful man do such signs?" And there was a division among them. So they said to the blind man again, "What do you have to say about him, since he opened your eyes?" He said, "He is a prophet." They answered and said to him, "You were born totally in sin, and are you trying to teach us?" Then they threw him out. When Jesus heard that they had thrown him out, he found him and said, "Do you believe in the Son of Man?" He answered and said, "Who is he, sir, that I may believe in him?" Jesus said to him, "You have seen him, and the one speaking with you is he." He said, "I do believe, Lord," and he worshiped him.

PROFESSION OF FAITH

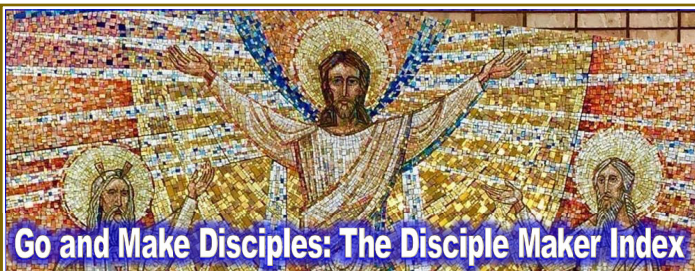

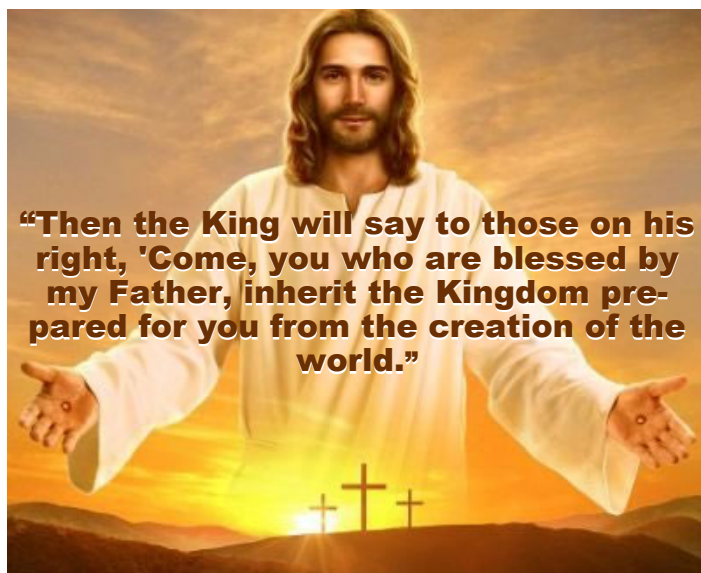
