Fourth Sunday of Easter

Acts 2:14a, 36-41 1 || Pt 2:20b-25 || Jn 10:1-10

GROW as a DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

CRECER como DISCÍPULOS | ORAR, ESTUDIAR, PARTICIPAR, SERVIR

There is much we could ponder in today's Scriptures, but the verses that stood out for me are these: "If you are patient when you suffer for doing what is good, this is a grace before God. For to this you have been called." I have a hard enough time keeping my inner child under wraps when I suffer due to my own sinfulness or incompetence, and Peter is telling me to be patient when I suffer for doing what is good? Well, yes – "because Christ also suffered for [us], leaving an example that [we] should follow in his footsteps." And the clarity of this truth hits me smack in the face. Doing what is good means we are loving another, in some way; we are doing good, for good. We are engaging in self-sacrifice, and some form of suffering is inherent to that. But here's the thing: it's an oddly joyful kind of suffering because it produces good fruit and directs our thoughts and vision to the one who is present among us as "the shepherd and guardian of [our] souls." Let us pray for the ability to see each moment of suffering for doing good as "a grace before God."

Hay mucho que podríamos reflexionar en las Escrituras de hoy, pero los versículos que me llamaron la atención son estos: "Si eres paciente cuando sufres por hacer el bien, esto es una gracia delante de Dios. Porque a esto has sido llamado." Me cuesta bastante mantener en secreto a mi niño interior cuando sufro debido a mi propia pecaminosidad o incompetencia, y Peter me dice que tenga paciencia cuando sufro por hacer lo que es bueno. Pues sí, "porque también Cristo padeció por [nosotros], dejando ejemplo para que [nosotros] sigamos sus huellas". Y la claridad de esta verdad me golpea de lleno en la cara. Hacer el bien significa que estamos amando a otro, de alguna manera; estamos haciendo el bien, para bien. Nos estamos involucrando en el auto-sacrificio, y alguna forma de sufrimiento es inherente a eso. Pero aquí está la cuestión: es un tipo de sufrimiento extrañamente gozoso porque produce buenos frutos y dirige nuestros pensamientos y nuestra visión hacia Aquel que está presente entre nosotros como "el pastor y guardián de [nuestras] almas". Oremos por la capacidad de ver cada momento de sufrimiento por hacer el bien como "una gracia ante Dios".

GO and EVANGELIZE | INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

VE y EVANGELIZA | INVITACIÓN, TESTIMONIO, ACOMPAÑAMIENTO

At this point in the Easter season, we might think, "Why can't we focus more on the joy of Jesus' resurrection and less on the suffering that preceded it?" Well, we certainly can ... but we would lose a great part of the Paschal Mystery. We don't embrace the cross for the sake of suffering in itself. We come to the crucifixion to pass through it. We are an Easter people living in a Good Friday world. There's no avoiding suffering in our lives, but the Good News of Jesus Christ is that he has redeemed that suffering. He has given us victory over death and is – quite literally – the way to eternal life. In the Gospel Jesus says, "Whoever enters through me will be saved ... I came so that they might have life and have it more abundantly." He is our shepherd and we know his voice. During this Eastertide we have an extraordinary opportunity to attend to that voice in a particular way, and to think about how we might be hearing it in a new way this year.

En este punto de la temporada de Pascua, podríamos pensar: "¿Por qué no podemos centrarnos más en el gozo de la resurrección de Jesús y menos en el sufrimiento que la precedió?" Bueno, ciertamente podemos... pero perderíamos una gran parte del Misterio Pascual. No abrazamos la cruz por causa del sufrimiento en sí mismo. Llegamos a la crucifixión para pasar por ella. Somos un pueblo de Pascua que vive en un mundo de Viernes Santo. No se puede evitar el sufrimiento en nuestras vidas, pero la Buena Nueva de Jesucristo es que él ha redimido ese sufrimiento. Él nos ha dado la victoria sobre la muerte y es, literalmente, el camino a la vida eterna. En el Evangelio, Jesús dice: "El que por mí entre, se salvará... He venido para que tengan vida y la tengan en abundancia". Él es nuestro pastor y conocemos su voz. Durante este tiempo de Pascua tenemos una oportunidad extraordinaria para atender esa voz de una manera particular y para pensar en cómo podríamos estar escuchándola de una manera nueva este año.

FIRST READING

God has made Jesus both Lord and Christ.

A reading from the Acts of the Apostles

—2: 14a, 36-41

Then Peter stood up with the Eleven, raised his voice, and proclaimed: "Let the whole house of Israel know for certain that God has made both Lord and Christ, this Jesus whom you crucified." Now when they heard this, they were cut to the heart, and they asked Peter and the other apostles, "What are we to do, my brothers?" Peter said to them, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. For the promise is made to you and to your children and to all those far off, whomever the Lord our God will call." He testified with many other arguments, and was exhorting them, "Save yourselves from this corrupt generation." Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand persons were added that day.

Jesus said: "Amen, amen, I say to you, whoever does not enter a sheepfold through the gate but climbs over elsewhere is a thief and a robber. But whoever enters through the gate is the shepherd of the sheep. The gatekeeper opens it for him, and the sheep hear his voice, as the shepherd calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. When he has driven out all his own, he walks ahead of them, and the sheep follow him, because they recognize his voice. But they will not follow a stranger; they will run away from him, because they do not recognize the voice of strangers." Although Jesus used this figure of speech, the Pharisees did not realize what he was trying to tell them.

So Jesus said again, "Amen, amen, I say to you, I am the gate for the sheep. All who came before me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not listen to them. I am the gate. Whoever enters through me will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture. A thief comes only to steal and slaughter and destroy; I came so that they might have life and have it more abundantly."

“Readers exercise a genuine liturgical function. They ought, therefore, to discharge their office with sincere piety and rightly expected by God’s people. Consequently, they must all be imbued with the spirit of the liturgy... and they must be trained to performed their functions in a correct and orderly manner.” (Constitution of Sacred Liturgy #29)

TALENTS NEEDED

To proclaim Scripture and other liturgical readings and prayers in a manner which allows the meaning and significance of the passage to be recognized by the assembly. “To carrying out this function and carefully prepared, so that by their hearing the readings from the sacred texts the faithful may conceive in their hearts a sweet and living affection for sacred Scripture.” (GIRM #101).

QUALIFICATIONS

A special love for the Scriptures. A good reading voice. Good public speaking skills. A strong desire to be a storyteller for the community. A willingness to take time preparing one’s reading(s). Sure and grateful movement. Training for the lector ministry is a 4—5 hour Saturday session which includes basic communication skills, methods of preparation for proclamation and specific directions for this ministry.

LEVEL OF COMMITMENT

Ministers are expected to serve when scheduled and get their own substitutes when necessary.

They are also expected to attend community building evenings, which include scripture reflection and faith sharing as well as opportunities for camaraderie and ministry updates.

Please note the following: Lectors are commissioned for 3 year period. At the end of the 3 year period, they should be commissioned again in a Special Mass Celebration.


