## Fifth Sunday of Easter

Acts 6:1-7 || 1 Pt 2:4-9 || Jn 14:1-12

### GROW as a DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

#### CRECER como DISCÍPULOS | ORAR, ESTUDIAR, PARTICIPAR, SERVIR

Recently, I went through a period of spiritual dryness, and I questioned my ability to make faith the central tenet of my life. Although I had always loved reading Scripture, I felt I needed reassurance that God was truly present with me. So I did what many people do: I asked God for a sign that he was real. Nothing happened. The sky didn't open; doves and rays of light didn't magically appear announcing God's presence. Although I didn't receive what I envisioned as a "heavenly sign," I looked down at the Bible in my hands and realized that God's word, handed down through the millennia, had been my companion all this time and was indeed the "sign" I was looking for. Which is why Jesus' question to Philip in today's Gospel struck a chord with me: "Have I been with you for so long a time and you still do not know me?" If Jesus asked me this same question, I want to be able to answer, "Yes, Lord, I know you through your sacred word, through partaking of the Eucharist and through the strength and guidance of the Holy Spirit who is with me each and every day."

Recientemente, pasé por un período de sequedad espiritual y cuestioné mi capacidad para hacer de la fe el principio central de mi vida. Aunque siempre me había gustado leer las Escrituras, sentí que necesitaba la seguridad de que Dios estaba realmente presente conmigo. Así que hice lo que mucha gente hace: le pedí a Dios una señal de que él era real. No pasó nada. El cielo no se abrió; palomas y rayos de luz no aparecían mágicamente anunciando la presencia de Dios. Aunque no recibí lo que imaginé como una "señal celestial", miré la Biblia que tenía en las manos y me di cuenta de que la palabra de Dios, transmitida a lo largo de los milenios, había sido mi compañera todo este tiempo y de hecho era la "señal". "Estaba buscando. Por eso me conmovió la pregunta de Jesús a Felipe en el Evangelio de hoy: "¿Tanto tiempo hace que estoy con vosotros y todavía no me conocéis?". Si Jesús me hiciera esta misma pregunta, quiero poder responder: "Sí, Señor, te conozco por tu sagrada palabra, por participar de la Eucaristía y por la fuerza y la guía del Espíritu Santo que está conmigo en todos y cada uno. cada día."

### GO and EVANGELIZE | INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

#### VE y EVANGELIZA | INVITACIÓN, TESTIMONIO, ACOMPAÑAMIENTO

What does "knowing Jesus" mean for me in my everyday life? It means hearing his words and acting on them: "I am the way and the truth and the life ... If you know me, then you will also know my Father." In following Christ, we know that Jesus is in the Father and the Father is in him. Jesus Christ is God! And as we heard in the second reading from Peter, we are not Christians on a lonely road; we are living stones that form a spiritual house. We are "called out of darkness into his wonderful light," as he describes it. Therefore, let us not be afraid to lean on our fellow Christians when we need support. And then, of course, we turn to Jesus, the cornerstone, the bedrock of our faith, and rejoice in his love for us.

¿Qué significa para mí "conocer a Jesús" en mi vida cotidiana? Significa escuchar sus palabras y ponerlas en práctica: "Yo soy el camino, la verdad y la vida... Si me conocéis a mí, conoceréis también a mi Padre". Siguiendo a Cristo, sabemos que Jesús está en el Padre y el Padre está en él. ¡Jesucristo es Dios! Y como escuchamos en la segunda lectura de Pedro, no somos cristianos en un camino solitario; somos piedras vivas que forman una casa espiritual. Somos "llamados de las tinieblas a su luz admirable", como él lo describe. Por lo tanto, no tengamos miedo de apoyarnos en nuestros hermanos cristianos cuando necesitemos apoyo. Y luego, por supuesto, nos volvemos a Jesús, la piedra angular, el cimiento de nuestra fe, y nos regocijamos en su amor por nosotros.

### ACTION | ACTUAR

Faith is rarely a straight path – sometimes there are sharp curves, steep hills, or roadblocks. If you feel lost or could use someone to talk to about faith, reach out to your parish and ask about contacting a spiritual director. Come, Holy Spirit, and fill me with your grace.

### FIRST READING

*They choose seven men filled with spirit.*

#### A reading from the Acts of the Apostles

—6: 1-7

As the number of disciples continued to grow, the Hellenists complained against the Hebrews because their widows were being neglected in the daily distribution. So the Twelve called together the community of the disciples and said, "It is not right for us to neglect the word of God to serve at table. Brothers, select from among you seven reputable men, filled with the Spirit and wisdom, whom we shall appoint to this task, whereas we shall devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word." The proposal was acceptable to the whole community, so they chose Stephen, a man filled with faith and the Holy Spirit, also Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicholas of Antioch, a convert to Judaism. They presented these men to the apostles who prayed and laid hands on them. The word of God continued to spread, and the number of the disciples in Jerusalem increased greatly; even a large group of priests were becoming obedient to the faith.

Se los presentaron a los apóstoles, y éstos, después de haber orado, les impusieron las manos. Mientras tanto, la palabra de Dios iba cundiendo. En Jerusalén se multiplicaba grandemente el número de los discípulos. Incluso un grupo numeroso de sacerdotes había aceptado la fe.

Amen, amen, I say to you, whoever believes in me will do the works that I do, and will do greater ones than these, because I am going to the Father."
