



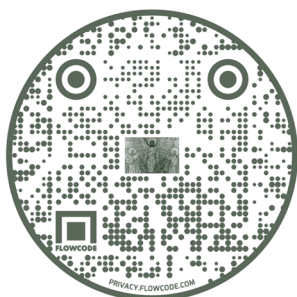

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, the true, real, and substantial presence of Jesus Christ under the appearances of bread and wine. As Catholics, we know that the Eucharist is not simply symbolic, but is in fact the body, blood, soul, and divinity of Christ who rose from the dead. Our readings remind us of this. In the Gospel Jesus says: "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh ... I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you." Although Jesus' words were very difficult for his disciples at the time to understand, we know that the bread and wine that become the body and blood of Jesus satisfy our deepest hunger. This spiritual food is actually an encounter with God through his Son, Jesus. It is a blessing that the Church provides us. Let us celebrate on this solemnity by giving thanks, which is what eucharist means!

Hoy celebramos la Solemnidad del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo, la presencia verdadera, real y sustancial de Jesucristo bajo las apariencias de pan y vino. Como católicos, sabemos que la Eucaristía no es simplemente simbólica, sino que de hecho es el cuerpo, la sangre, el alma y la divinidad de Cristo que resucitó de entre los muertos. Nuestras lecturas nos recuerdan esto. En el Evangelio Jesús dice: "Yo soy el pan vivo bajado del cielo; el que come de este pan vivirá para siempre; y el pan que yo daré es mi carne... Os digo que si no coméis la carne del Hijo del hombre y bebéis su sangre, no tenéis vida dentro de vosotros". Aunque las palabras de Jesús fueron muy difíciles de entender para sus discípulos en ese momento, sabemos que el pan y el vino que se convierten en el cuerpo y la sangre de Jesús satisfacen nuestra hambre más profunda. Este alimento espiritual es en realidad un encuentro con Dios a través de su Hijo, Jesús. Es una bendición que nos brinda la Iglesia. ¡Celebremos esta solemnidad dando gracias, que es lo que significa la eucaristía!

GO and EVANGELIZE | INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

VE y EVANGELIZA | INVITACIÓN, TESTIMONIO, ACOMPAÑAMIENTO

There was a priest at my home parish who could spend hours – literally, hours – sitting in eucharistic adoration. If he wasn't out and about serving our parish or in his office for a meeting, you would find him in the adoration chapel gazing at the monstrance which displayed the consecrated host, the Blessed Sacrament. He always would have a small smile on his face, happily losing himself in the Lord. Although everyone has different time pressures on them during the course of a typical week, I think we can all agree that spending only one hour a week with someone is not enough to maintain an important relationship. The same is true with our relationship with Christ. Let's make an effort in the coming weeks to enhance that relationship by spending more time with him. Do you have an hour for adoration? Experience the peace it can bring. Or perhaps now is the time to check the daily Mass schedule in your parish and try to attend once or twice. Jesus offers us his very body and blood under the appearances of bread and wine. Don't squander the opportunity to receive this precious gift.

Había un sacerdote en mi parroquia natal que podía pasar horas, literalmente horas, sentado en adoración eucarística. Si no estuviera fuera y sirviendo a nuestra parroquia o en su oficina para una reunión, lo encontraría en la capilla de adoración mirando la custodia que mostraba la hostia consagrada, el Santísimo Sacramento. Siempre tenía una pequeña sonrisa en su rostro, felizmente perdiéndose en el Señor. Aunque todos tienen diferentes presiones de tiempo durante el transcurso de una semana típica, creo que todos podemos estar de acuerdo en que pasar solo una hora a la semana con alguien no es suficiente para mantener una relación importante. Lo mismo es cierto con nuestra relación con Cristo. Hagamos un esfuerzo en las próximas semanas para mejorar esa relación pasando más tiempo con él. ¿Tienes una hora para la adoración? Experimente la paz que puede traer. O tal vez ahora es el momento de revisar el horario de misas diarias en su parroquia e intentar asistir una o dos veces. Jesús nos ofrece su mismo cuerpo y sangre bajo las apariencias de pan y vino. No desaproveche la oportunidad de recibir este precioso regalo.

Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him. Just as the living Father sent me and I have life because of the Father, so also the one who feeds on me will have life because of me. This is the bread that came down from heaven. Unlike your ancestors who ate and still died, whoever eats this bread will live forever."

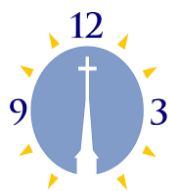

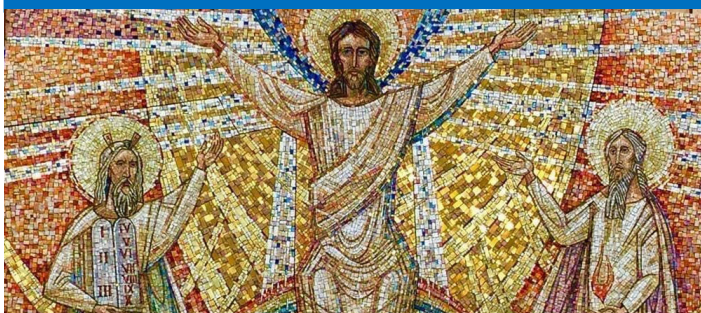
