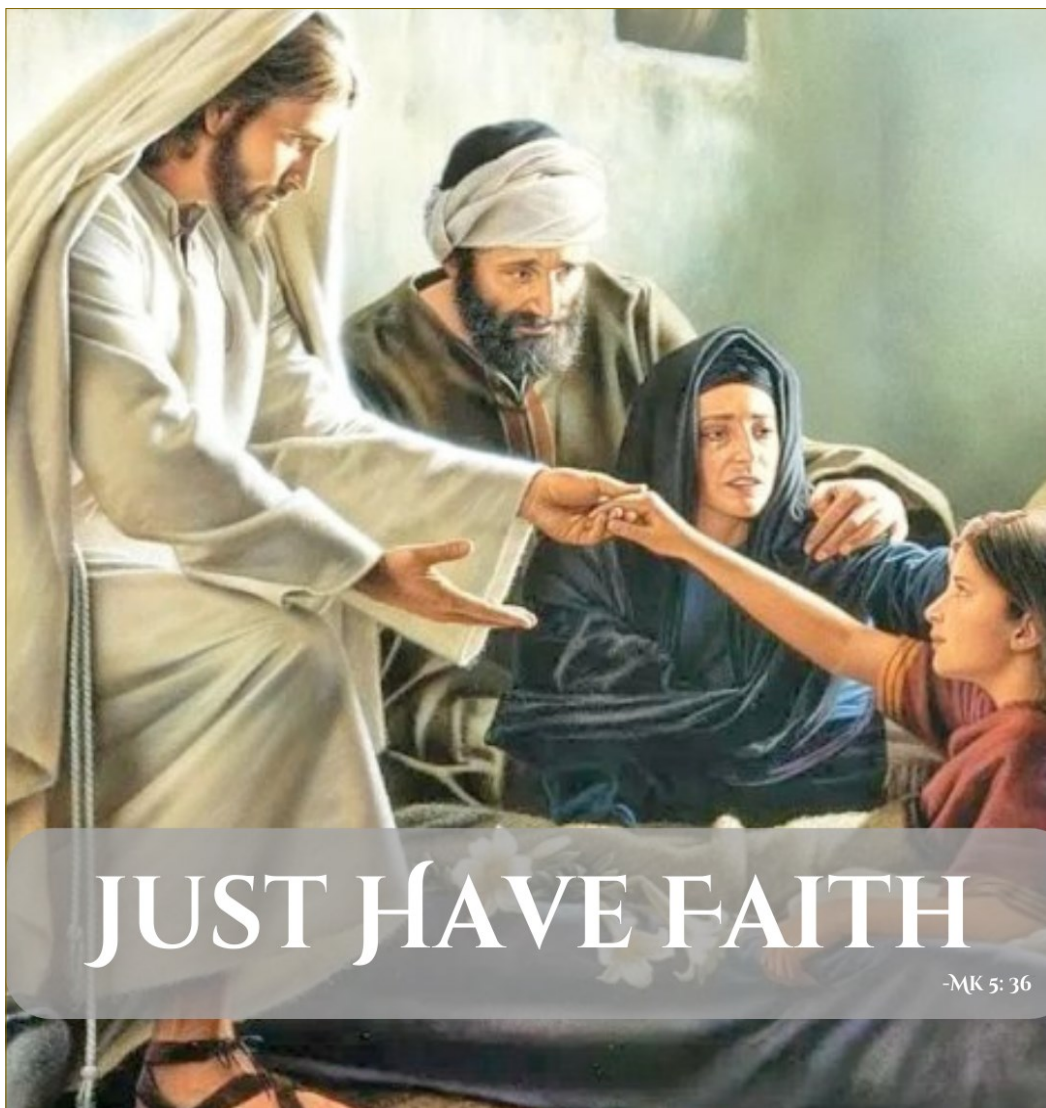
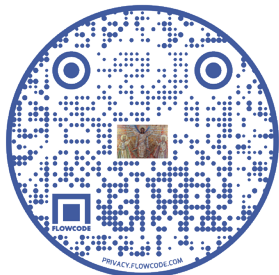

Parishioners:

It's summertime – what a great time of year! I just want to give you an update regarding the parish finances. As of today, under the leadership of our pastor, Fr. Juan Pablo we have kept current on all our bills and have zero loans with the archdiocese. We currently have \$7,300 in our Improvement Fund if a necessary repair is needed. All donations to that fund stay in a separate account to only use for an unbudgeted building repair.

Our weekly budget to cover salaries and ordinary expenses is \$11,000. Since the start of this calendar year, we have hit our budgeted amount 10 of the 24 weeks or 42% of the time. If we do not meet or exceed this budgeted amount 100% of the time, we will run into a situation that we do not want to be in. It will mean we need to take a loan from the archdiocese. Fr. Juan Pablo and I worked hard to get our loan from many years ago forgiven and prefer not to go that route. We understand the cost of living and everyday expenses have risen as the costs for running the parish have also. We will in the upcoming fiscal year start to think of a major fundraiser to help offset costs.

We thank you so much for your financial support of the parish and ministries. I have been a parishioner in this parish for 49 years and have always found we have the best parishioners anywhere. We truly are the definition of a Catholic community.

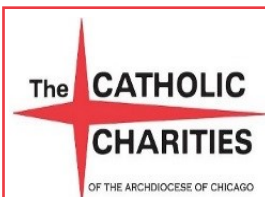

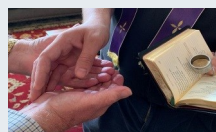
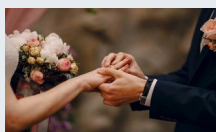
