

THIS WEEK'S MINISTRY SPOTLIGHT

Prayer Pillar



The prayer pillar focuses on both public and private prayer for our parishioners. The pillar does much for our prayer life throughout the year. For example, on Wednesday evenings we have Adoration of the Eucharist (where the sacrament of reconciliation is also often offered to those who wish to participate). For more than a year now, parishioners meet in the Gathering Place on Sunday mornings at 9:30 between masses to pray the Liturgy of the Hours Morning Prayer together for 15 minutes. If you wish to join stop in.

The Liturgy and Eucharist each Sunday (and Saturday evening) are the foremost exercise of our public prayer. Each of us participates in the mass as part of the worship community where Jesus Christ renews his sacrifice for each of us. Some of us participate more visibly, sharing our gifts at the mass.

The music and choir provide fundamental worship throughout both phases of the mass. Our choir has grown through the years so we can now provide a full choir at Sunday 10:00 mass as well as cantors and music at the other masses. Nevertheless, we are always in need of more voices. Please see Chris O'Brien after mass to discuss participating as a member of the choir.

We have been fortunate in having men, women, and children serving as altar servers at mass over the years. We have had parents and their children participating together at mass. Anyone who has served the mass as an altar server can tell you that there is an appreciation of the mass from such service that cannot be acquired from any other vantage point. We often need more altar servers, especially for 4PM and 8AM masses. Adults are welcome to serve.

Similarly, anyone who has served as an Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist can tell you that after such service they feel a connection with the Holy Spirit in their sharing the Body and Blood of Christ with all the faithful. Perhaps your calling is to serve as a Eucharistic Minister. Those who are gifted speakers may serve as lectors.





EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP

Play That One Again

How many times have you sung the church song, “Here I Am, Lord”? If you grew up Catholic and are around my age (still 50!), the answer is more than you can count. The song that quotes various verses of Scripture is sung using guitar, piano, or organ, by cantors and choirs, in traditional and modern churches. It is truly a Catholic greatest hit of the modern Church. The question is how many times when singing the refrain have you really taken to heart what you were singing.

“Here I am, Lord; is it I, Lord? I have heard you calling in the night.” Like the biblical figure Samuel, we are responding to the call of God by asking for clarification that we are indeed the one being called. We then follow up the question with a profound statement: “I will go if You lead me.” It is profound because we are pledging to our God that we are willing to go wherever He wants. We are accepting the challenge put forth in the U.S. Bishops’ pastoral letter, “Stewardship: A Disciple’s Response,” to become mature disciples who respond to the call of Jesus Christ regardless of the cost. We have sung this pledge repeatedly for many years.

We never have any idea what God will call us to do and where to go. Sometimes the request can ask us for quite a lot. Hopefully, we respond like a mature disciple. If not, maybe we should reflect more the next time this song is played. The melody will not allow for the words, “I will see if I am busy and then decide to go if you lead me.” Then again, I don’t want to sing that to God, the source of all life anyway. Do you?




