# One Church – One Message

## Lenten Message Series

### INTRODUCTION: **Three Shocking Truths**


**Scripture:** Mark 3:1-3

We begin with a story where Jesus heals a man with a withered hand. The healing takes place in a hostile setting, reminding us that healing is not always comfortable. It takes courage, tenderness, and trust in what we cannot fully understand.

**What does God want us to know?** This week's message reminds us that words hold incredible power. They shape our lives, influence our relationships, and reflect the image of the God who spoke creation into being. Scripture tells us that "death and life are in the power of the tongue" (Proverbs 18:21). Just as the early Church grew through the spread of God's Word, we grow stronger and more faithful when His Word shapes the way we speak and live. Our words can wound or heal, tear down or build up.

**What does God want us to feel?** We are invited to feel both convicted and encouraged. Convicted when our words are careless or critical, and encouraged that God offers grace to speak with love and wisdom. The examples of mothers, mentors, and Christ Himself remind us that words rooted in love can change lives. Gratitude rises as we remember those who have spoken life into us and inspired us to do the same for others.

**What does God want us to do?** This week, commit to engaging fully in the More than Words series, in person and small faith groups. Spend time each day in Scripture, beginning with the Acts of the Apostles, and let God's Word shape your words. Choose to speak encouragement instead of complaint, name reality without dwelling on the negative, and use your words to lift up your family, parish, and community. In doing so, we honor those who taught us that joy grows when it is shared and that words guided by God bear lasting fruit.

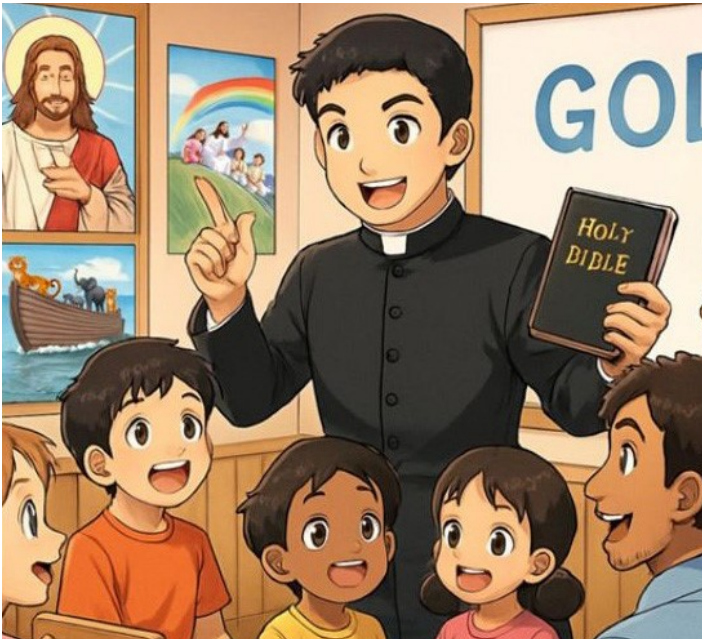

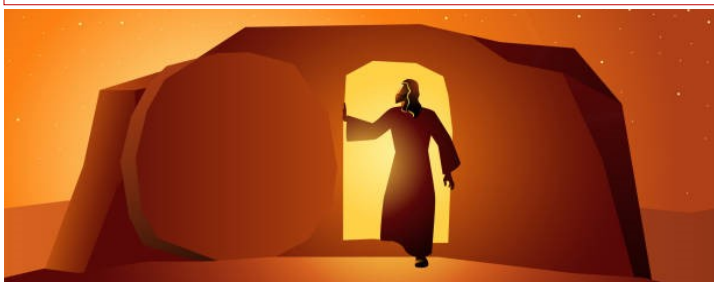
