Lenten Message Series

WEEK TWO: The Shadow of the Cross—Wounded Healer—Listen to Him

Scripture: Matthew 17:1-9

The Transfiguration foreshadows the cross. Jesus takes Peter, James and John up the mountain to pray to bolster their faith during his Passion. The Father tells the apostles to listen to Jesus. Jesus is the wounded healer. He can heal us because he has entered totally and completely into our human condition, even experiencing death, death on the cross. In Jesus we have someone who is both human and divine. Humans know our suffering and pain. Divine he can do something about it. Our role is to listen to him.

What does God want us to know? Everyone carries wounds, and healing is part of God's plan for restoration. Jesus came to renew what has been broken and to make all things new. Wounds do not define identity or determine the future. God can use even the deepest pain for redemption and victory. Because Jesus has suffered in every way, he offers trustworthy wisdom and real healing, and every path to healing is personal and unique.

What does God want us to feel? Encouraged, understood, and hopeful. There is comfort in knowing that pain is seen and not wasted, that wounds are not ignored or minimized, and that God is near and attentive. There is reassurance that healing is possible and that intimacy with God often grows most deeply in places of vulnerability.

What does God want us to do? Listen to Jesus. Choose to rely on the Lord rather than self-reliance. Acknowledge wounds honestly and bring them into God's presence. Spend intentional time listening to Jesus in prayer, especially through quiet reflection and adoration. Invite him into places of pain, trust his guidance, and remain open to the unique way healing may unfold through an ongoing, personal relationship with him .

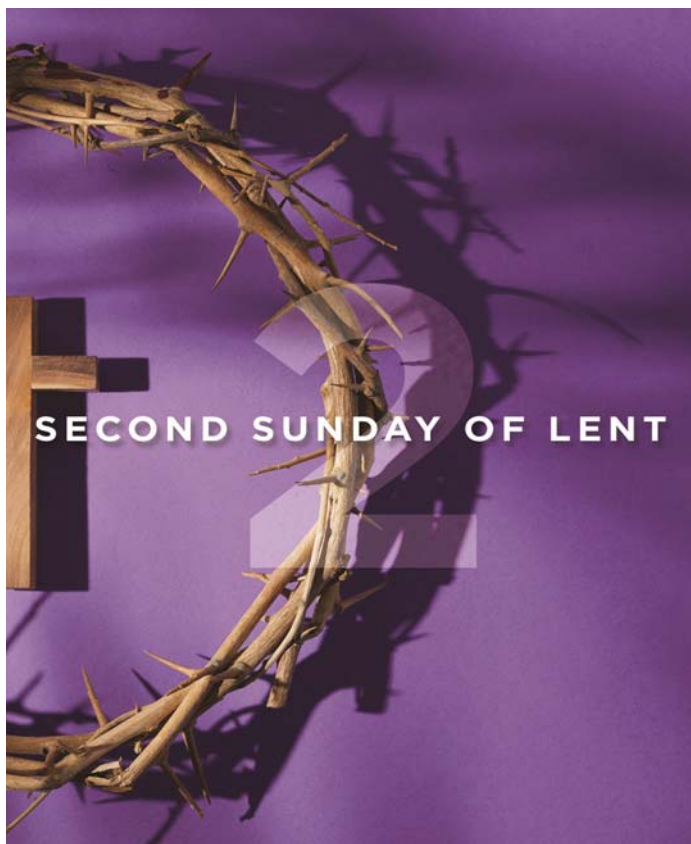

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP

The 6 Characteristics of an Everyday Stewardship for Lent – Prayerful

When my children were younger, they could make me laugh and sometimes cry. I would have conversations about animals, nature, outer space, and so many amazing things in life. I would play with them one day and then work to bandage a boo-boo the next. There were so many dynamics to our relationship. However, one aspect was my favorite. It was when one of them would snuggle up next to me on the couch silently, often leading to sleep. There was no better feeling, and I didn’t want to move for anything. It is crazy to think of all the things we would do together, and my favorite was when we essentially were doing nothing.

Do you think God desires a portion of you? Without a doubt, He wants all of you: the good, the bad, and the ugly. Walking with Him daily is so important, and we can never become the disciples and stewards we need to be without a deepening relationship. Yet, prayer is not just talking and listening. It is also being. We sometimes seek to communicate so much and do so many things that we forget the value of stewardship of presence. The giving of ourselves completely to another often requires us to simply be with that person. We feel their presence. We rest in their being. No words are needed because words would destroy the moment. This is what we are called to in a relationship with God. This is good stewardship because it is about giving of our very presence to God and receiving strength from that resting in Him. Sometimes, all we need is to snuggle up to our God on the couch.

Lenten Disciplines of Fasting & Abstinence

Norms of fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59.

Fridays of Lent: Obligatory abstinence from meat for everyone 14 and older.

Fasting Definition: One full meatless meal, and two smaller, meatless meals that together do not equal a full meal. No snacks are permitted

Abstinence Definition: No consumption of meat (beef, pork, chicken,). Fish, seafood, and animal products like eggs and dairy are allowed.

Exemptions: Those with medical conditions, including chronic illnesses like diabetes, pregnant or nursing women, are not bound by these rules.

Other Practices: Beyond obligatory rules, Catholics are encouraged to engage in voluntary fasting, prayer, and almsgiving throughout the 40 days

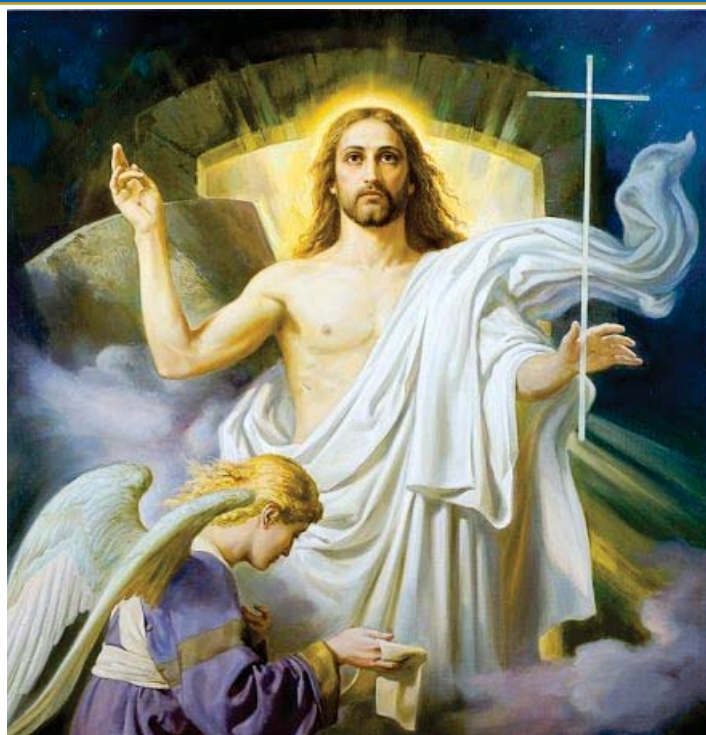

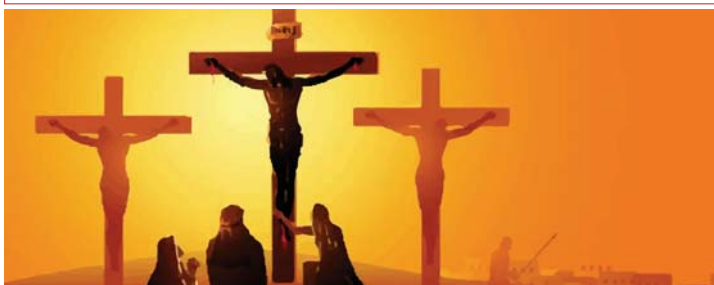
