# One Church — One Message

## Lenten Message Series

### WEEK THREE: **Don't Go There—Ripping Off Band Aid**

**Scripture:** John 4:5-42


This week we will look at the story of the woman at the well. Jesus intentionally goes into the woman's wound. He brings up the fact that the woman is not married and she has had five husbands. Five men have married and then discarded her. Jesus rips open the wound. The encounter shows that Jesus will actually take us to our wounds not because he wants to hurt us but because he wants to heal us. And we cannot be healed if we don't invite him in. In this message we will look at wounds of the heart and how Jesus wants to heal us.

**What does God want us to know?** Everyone has an emotional and spiritual wound and that comes with a message. Jesus will lead us into our emotional wounds so he can heal us and give us a new message of being loved and accepted.

**What does God want us to feel?** Safe, accepted, and hopeful. There is reassurance in knowing that wounds can be named without fear of rejection and that Jesus sees everything and still offers love. There is freedom in realizing that pain does not have to control life and that healing, though sometimes uncomfortable, leads to peace and restoration.

**What does God want us to do?** Stop running from or managing pain and instead face it with honesty. Invite the Holy Spirit to reveal hidden wounds and the lies connected to them. Bring those wounds directly to Jesus in prayer, allowing him to speak truth, love, and mercy into those places. Take concrete steps toward healing through prayer, sacramental grace, and openness to God's work, trusting that freedom lies on the other side of the pain.

## Lenten Disciplines of Fasting & Abstinence

*Norms of fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59.*

**Fridays of Lent:** Obligatory abstinence from meat for everyone 14 and older.

**Fasting Definition:** One full meatless meal, and two smaller, meatless meals that together do not equal a full meal. No snacks are permitted

**Abstinence Definition:** No consumption of meat (beef, pork, chicken,). Fish, seafood, and animal products like eggs and dairy are allowed.

**Exemptions:** Those with medical conditions, including chronic illnesses like diabetes, pregnant or nursing women, are not bound by these rules.

**Other Practices:** Beyond obligatory rules, Catholics are encouraged to engage in voluntary fasting, prayer, and almsgiving throughout the 40 days

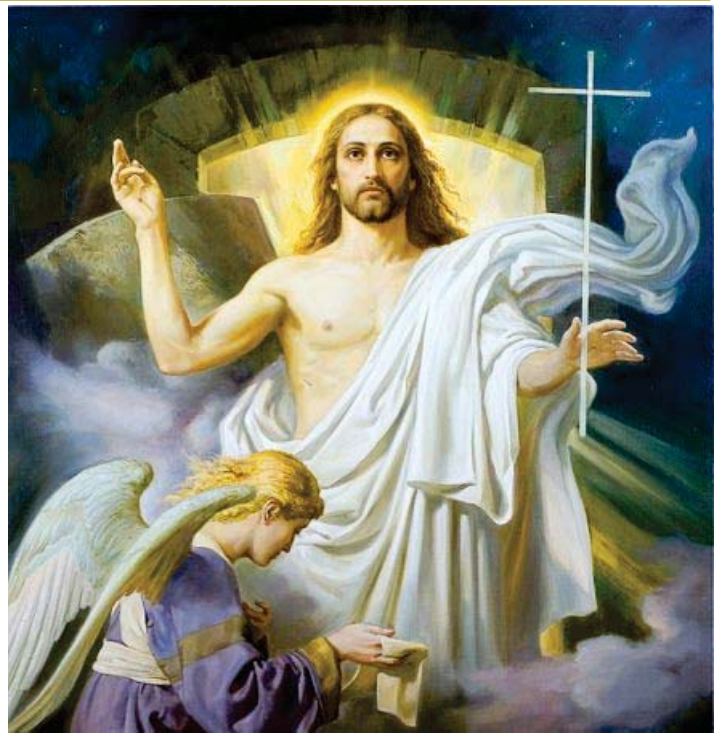

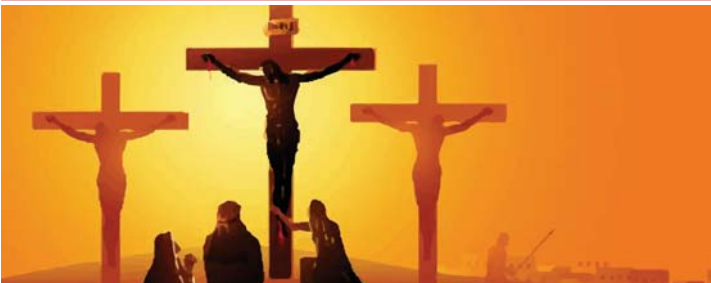

## Sacrament of Reconciliation Confesiones / Sakrament Pojednania

**Before Confession:** Prepare by making an Examination of Conscience

*A prayer before Confession: Dear Jesus, help me to make a good Confession, help me to find out my sins, help me to be sorry for them, help me to make up my mind not to sin again. Have mercy on me, O Lord, and forgive me. Mary, my mother, pray for me.*

**During Confession:** Greeting: Make the Sign of the Cross in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Say: *“Bless me, Father, for I have sinned. It has been \_\_\_\_ (weeks, months, years) since my last confession.”* Confess your sins using the Examination of Conscience. If you are unsure of what to say, ask the priest for help. When you are finished, conclude with these or similar words: *“I am sorry for these and all my sins.”*

**Penance:** The priest will propose an act of penance. The penance might be a prayer, a work of mercy, or an act of charity. He might also counsel you on how to better live a Christian life. Act of Contrition: Say an Act of Contrition, expressing sorrow for your sins and resolving to leave sin behind and live more like Jesus Christ. Say: *My God, I am sorry for my sins with my whole heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. With your help, I firmly indent to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Our Savior, Jesus Christ, suffered and died for us. In his name, my God, have mercy.*

**Absolution:** The priest then blessed you in the person of Christ as he says the prayer of Absolution which frees you from your sins. After Confession: - - Rejoice that through the grace of the Sacrament of Reconciliation God has reminded you of his unending love! Follow through with the penance the priest gave you.
